### **GOVERNING RULES**

- 1 Entries with fees to reach Secretary, Mrs M R Gorman, 28, Aberfoyle, Ouston, Chester-Le-Street, Co Durham, DH2 1RH on or before Monday, 8 April 2024. Entries will be accepted by cash or via bank transfer -Mrs Martha R Gorman sort code 77-29-18 account no 46516568. 2 No entries will be accepted without fees and no late entries will be accepted. A registered teacher must sign all entries. 3 Age to be taken from 1 January 2024. 4 The Adjudicator's decision is final. 5 Beginners and Primary Competitions are open to all regions and dancers, up to and including the Under 12 age group, may only wear traditional class costumes or long/short sleeved blouses/shirts and skirts/trousers, polo tops and skirts/trousers, body suits and skirts or tunics that conform to the regular costume length rule. Low-cut tops and short tight skirts are not permitted. Beginners are open to dancers who have never won a 1<sup>st</sup> placed medal 6 in that particular dance in any age group and must dance basic steps. 7 Primary competitions are open to dancers who have never won a 1<sup>st</sup> place in that particular dance in any age group. Intermediate competitions are open to dancers who have never won a 8 1<sup>st</sup> place in that particular dance in their present age group. Beginner and Primary Trophy Reel competitions are only open to those 9 who have danced in the respective Reel competitions and have not previously won a Trophy Reel competition in any age group. Intermediate Trophy Reel competitions are open to dancers who have danced in the Intermediate Reel on the day and have not previously won an Intermediate Reel competition in their present age group. 10 If there are 5 or less competitors in any Beginner, Primary or Intermediate competition this will not count for grading purposes. However, a dancer may only win 3 such competitions and then move to the next grade. 11 If there are 15 or more competitors in any Beginner Competition, the 1<sup>st</sup> 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> placed dancers will move up to the next grade. If there are less than 15 only the 1<sup>st</sup> placed will count. With the exception of U5, U6 and U7, any dancer who has won an 12
  - Open Championship must dance in the open grade in the calendar year in which this was won.
  - 13 Any dancer in U5, U6 or U7 age group, who has previously won an Open Championship, must dance Open for the dances performed in the Championship. They may dance their other dances in the appropriate

- grade. Dancers must dance in the solo competitions in order to dance in the 14 Premier/Special Premier/Open Championship (Under 5, 6, 7, 8 and 9 age groups).
- 15 Special Premier Competitions are confined to dancers who have never won a Special Premier, Open Premier, Preliminary Championship or Open Championship. A dancer must compete in at least 2 solo competitions (one Light dance and one Heavy dance, if applicable) to be eligible to dance in Special Premier Competitions. If less than 5 in any Special Premier Competition, the competition will be combined into a two yearly age group.

#### 16 **Preliminary Championships**

- A minimum number of three Adjudicators must officiate. •
- The first age group for a Preliminary Championship is under 10. •
- Where a Preliminary Championship is held separate from an Open Championship, three rounds should be offered, namely, Reel or Slip Jig, Heavy Jig or Hornpipe, and any Set Dance.
- Where a Preliminary Championship is combined with an Open Championship, then the result should be taken from eligible dancers' ranking after the first two rounds.
- Where there are separate Preliminary and Open Championships, dancers can compete in both at the discretion of the feis organiser.
- Where a competitor wins two Preliminary Championships, they must dance in Open Championship for a period of 12 months thereafter.
- For grading purposes, two wins will be taken as being in any two-year rolling period. Where a dancer does not win a second Preliminary within two years of winning their first Preliminary Championship, then the first win will be deemed as having expired and the dancer starts afresh.
- Where there are less than 6 in a Preliminary Championship, that win will not normally be considered for grading purposes. However, where a dancer wins three Preliminary Championships, regardless of the number of competitors in each competition, that dancer must dance in Open Championship for a period of 12 months thereafter.
- Dances performed in a Preliminary Championship do not count for grading in solo competitions.
- Dancers placing 1st 3rd in an Open Championship with up to 20 competitors, or 1st – 5th in an Open Championship with more than 20 competitors, cannot compete in a Preliminary Championship for a period of 12 months.
- A solo World Qualifier (in the previous 12 months) will NOT be eligible to compete in a Preliminary Championship; the exception to this would

of which may be required) will be exempt from this ruling. 32 Length of costume must adhere to principles of modesty and enable dancers to safely execute their movements and steps. Adjudicators who determine a costume to be too short or to lack modestly may ask a competitor to wear black tights (of a denier not less than 70 percent) in order to continue in the competition. For competitions adjudicated by a panel of more than one adjudicator, all adjudicators on the panel must agree to asking the dancer to wear tights. (Effective from 1 March 2022). 33 Appropriate undergarments covering the midriff must be worn. Undergarments must provide full coverage as per the illustration attached. (See Addendum A of this syllabus). Dancers wearing undergarments that do not cover the areas of the body as in the illustrated example will be asked to put on black tights of a denier of not less than 70%. This is monitored by the adjudicator. For competitions adjudicated by a panel of more than one adjudicator all adjudicator on the panel must agree to ask the dancer to put on tights. (Effective from 1 March 2022). 34 Make-up will not be permitted for any dancer in the first two grades (Beginners and Primary) up to and including the under 12 age group worldwide. For the purpose of this rule, the term "make-up" includes tinted moisturizer and any artificial tanning products. Make-up (including false evelashes and tanner on the face) is not permitted for dancers, in either solo or team competitions, up to and including the Under 10 age group. 35 No block, en pointe movements, stationary or moving, are allowed to be performed for all ages up to and including the Under 12 Age Group worldwide. However, dancers, who are moving into the Under 13 Age Group in January, will be permitted to do block/en Pointe work from September 1<sup>st</sup> of the year prior to this date. 36 The feis committee may modify, alter or cancel any arrangement in the syllabus as is deemed necessary, subject to approval of the North East Regional Council. 37 Respect for fellow competitors on stage is a requirement at all times. Lack of respect or courtesy for fellow competitors by aggressive dancing on stage will be subject to penalty at the discretion of each individual adjudicator. 


