Bun Grád

Age groups: Under 6, 6-7, 7-8, 8-9, 9-10, 10-12, 12-14, over 14

Bun Grád Championship: Ril & Port Eadtrom

Bun Grád Solos: Port Luasca, Port Singil.

Championship will be danced first, followed by slip jig and single jig solos. Reel and Light Jig will be danced once. Reel or Light Jig may be danced as a separate solo if child is not competing in championship.

Tús Grád

Age groups: Under 6, 6-7, 7-8, 8-9, 9-10, 10-12, 12-14, over 14

Dances: Ril, Port Luasca, Port Eadtrom, Port Singil, Port Trom, Cornphiopa

Tus Grád Championship:

U6/6-7: Any two light dances

6-7 upwards: Lá Féile Pádraig & Any Light Dance (Trad set will be danced first).

Age groups: Under 6, 6-7, 7-8, 8-9, 9-10, 10-11, 11-12, 12-14, over 14

Dances: Ril, Port Luasca, Port Eadtrom, Port Singil, Port Trom, Cornpíopa, Seit Tradisiúnta.

7-8 upwards: Seit Tradisiúnta and Any Light dance (Trad Set will be danced first)

Rialacha

1. Age to be taken as on 1st January, 2018.
2. Entries accepted only from teachers registered with An Coimisiun le Rinci Gaelacha.
3. The Adjudicator's decision is final. Adjudicators are to be approached by Committee members only.
4. Any objections must be made in writing to feis organisers within one hour, signed and accompanied by a fee of €20 which will be returned if objection is sustained.
5. The feis committee will not be responsible for any personal injury or articles lost at the feis. The committee, as far as practical, will provide a stage surface suitable for dancing. However, the committee cannot accept any liability whatsoever for injuries sustained while on stage. The lodgement of any entry will be deemed to be acceptance of these rules by a dancer and his/her parents/guardian.
6. Bungrad competitions are confined to dancers who have never won a 1st place in that specific dance and basic steps only are permitted.
7. Tusgrad competitions are confined to dancers who have never won 1st place in Tusgrad or Meangrad for that specific dance. Basic steps or the first difficult version of each dance only.
8. Preliminary: Preliminary Championships (8-9 years upwards) are confined to competitors who have not been placed in the top 5 in an Open Championship judged by 3 or more adjudicators. The dancer must not have qualified for the Worlds in 2017 or 2018 (with the exception of the boys who are eligible if they qualified but were not placed in the top 3 at their Regional Oireachtas and who otherwise fulfil the Prelim criteria). Dancer must have not recalled in the actual Championship at the All-Ireland 2017 or 2018. Competitors must not have won a Preliminary Championship more than two times in the current year. If the dancer has not succeeded in placing in the top 5 but has won two Preliminary Championships in the current year, they are eligible to dance preliminary again the following year.
9. Make up, wigs or solo costumes are not permitted in the Bungrad or Tusgrad competitions.
10. All dancers will be required to dance a minimum of 40 bars, except slip jig and hornpipe where a minimum of 32 bars will be required.
11. Any form of unauthorised photography which has the ability to capture a dancer's image whilst in motion is strictly forbidden.
