


Dear Teacher,

The Reid McKernon School would like to welcome you all to our 7th annual Grade, Prelim and Championship fairs. The fairs this year will be held on 8th and 9th November 2014. Under 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16, 17, 18 and over 18 open championships and prelim championships will take place on **Saturday 8th November**. Under 6, 7, 8 and 9 open championships and all the grades will take place on **Sunday 9th November 2014**.

We will be holding our fairs in **Hightown School**, Hightown road, North Belfast. This venue has excellent facilities for spectators and competitors. There will be a special covering to prevent slipping while in motion. There will be hot and cold food facilities provided.

Entries will be taken on the day.

This year we will have 2 stages running for the grades and one stage for the open and prelim championship.

Preliminary championships will be incorporated within the open championships and will be judged on Round 1 & Round 2 for under 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16. Anyone who does not recall in the open championship will dance a traditional set dance and will receive a separate solo result for the traditional set. Sashes and trophies will be awarded to 1st - 3rd place winners.

In Open championships where there are 15 or more competitors there will be a recall for the set dance. Those who do not recall will take part in a traditional set competition. Sashes and trophies will be awarded to 1st - 5th place winners.

In trophy competitions, 1st, 2nd and 3rd place winners will receive a trophy.



Feis Rules

1. Adjudicators decision is final.
 2. Age as at 1st January 2014.
 3. To be eligible for the preliminary championship a dancer must:
 - a) Not have previously won an open championship judged by 3 or more adjudicators
 - b) Not have won more than 3 preliminary championships judged by 3 or more adjudicators.
 - c) Not have qualified for Oireachtas Rince na Cruinne in either 2011 or 2012.
 4. All dancers will be required to dance a minimum number of 40 bars except in Súp Jigs, Hornpipes and Bun Grad Reels where a minimum of 32 bars will be required.
 5. No block, en-pointe, stationary or moving will be allowed for all ages up to and including Under 11.
 6. The Feis Committee reserves the right to (A) transfer competitions to a different hall and (B) alternate competitions if it becomes necessary in order to help run the feis smoothly. (C) Relief an adjudicator.
 7. No Recording or any form of unauthorized photography which will be able to capture a dancer performing e.g.- mobile phone, cameras, video cameras, cine recorder, commercial film, with or without flash is strictly forbidden. Anyone who breaks this rule will be asked to leave.
 8. Entries only accepted from teachers registered with An Comisiun Le Rinci Gaelacha.
 9. Changing in the halls is forbidden.
 10. Entrance In/Out of the venue will be monitored.
 11. Objections will only be considered if lodged in writing and accompanied by a fee of £20.00.
 12. Competitors must be ready at least 15 minutes prior to the start time of each competition.
 13. All competitors must dance in strict order that is requested of them. Anyone missing rotation will be disqualified.
 14. Bun Grad competitions are confined to dancers who have never won 1st place in that particular dance in any age group or grade. Basic Steps only.
 15. Tus Grad competitions are confined to dancers who have never won 1st place for that particular dance in any age group in Tus Grad, Meán Grad or Ard Grad.
 16. Meán Grad competitions are confined to dancers that have never won 1st place for that particular dance in Meán Grad or Ard Grad in that age group or a higher age group.
 17. Bun Grad and Tus Grad, make up will not be permitted. Dancers must wear class costumes or 'day clothes'.
 18. All Competitions are held under the rules and regulation of An Comisiun Le Rinci Gaelacha.

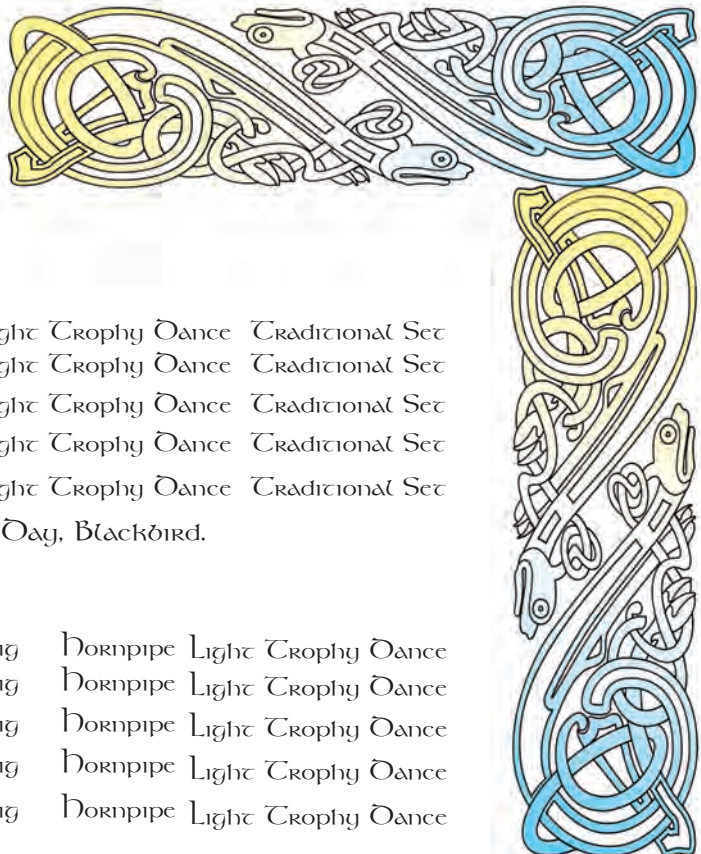
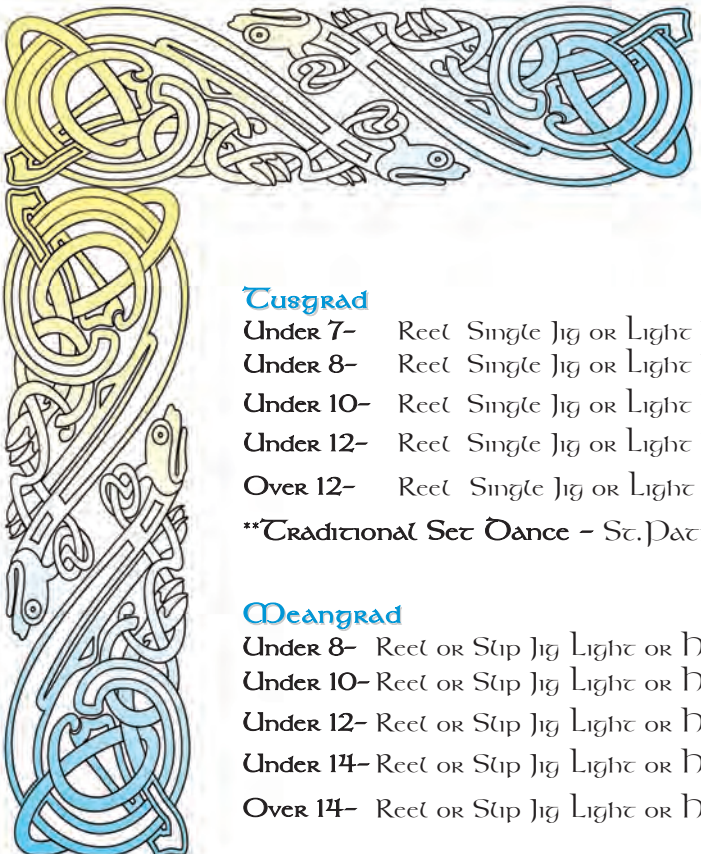
