LEVEL ADVANCEMENT AND DEFINITION

First Feis is not per dance, it is the first Feis ever for the dancer. Only one first feis regardless of how many dances they are doing. Dancers may only enter First Feis once even in case of back-to-back feiseanna.

In B1, B2 and Novice the following will apply:

5 - 9 dancers 1st place will advance to the next grade
 10 or more dancers 1st and 2nd places will advance to the next grade

Dancers may not stay in level at Teacher discretion

Prizewinner: Advancement from Prizewinner to Preliminary Championship is at teacher discretion.

Preliminary to Open Championship: Must have 3 overall wins with 5 or more dancers, not at teacher discretion. Upon winning 3rd overall win in Preliminary Championships, a dancer must move immediately to Open, even in the case of back-to-back Feiseanna. This includes 2 round and 3 round Preliminary Championships.

Adults: Dancers who started after the age of 18 or have been out of competitions for 5 years
