- If there are 8 competitors or more from age 16-17 and up in each particular age group ie. 16-17, 17-18 etc. a separate championship will be run.

RULES

- 1. Entries will be taken on day of feis and will only be accepted from teachers currently registered with CLRG 'An Coimisiún le Rincí Gaelacha'.
- 2. Age will be reckoned from the 1st January 2016.
- 3. The adjudicators' decision will be final.
- 4. Objections must be submitted in writing within one hour of the announcement of the result of that particular competition and accompanied by a fee of £20.00.
- 5. The feis committee will not accept any responsibility for personal injuries or articles lost at the feis.
- 6. There is no smoking permitted in the hall and we would ask that all attending respect the venue.
- 7. Any form of unauthorised photography which has the capability to capture a dancer's image whilst in motion, using electronic or manual means e.g. mobile phone, standard camera, video camcorder, commercial film, with or without enhancement, is expressly forbidden in competition, except in Beginner and Advanced Beginner categories (ie. Bun and Tús Grád) are exempt from this ruling unless this is in contravention of the local laws of the region or country).
- 8. Bun Grád and Tús Grád competitions are confined to dancers who have never won 1st prize in that particular dance in any age or grade. (Bun Grád: basic steps only).
- 9. Meán Grád is confined to dancers who have never won 1st prize in that particular dance or age group in either Meán or Árd Grád.
- 10. In Árd Grád championships cups and sashes will be presented to winners from 1st to 5th place & in Pre-lim cups and sashes will be presented to winners from 1st to 3rd place.
- 11. There will be separate male championships if there are more than 5 boys entered in championships 7-8 and upwards.
- 12. Competitors in all age groups, up to but excluding Meán Grád (Intermediate), may only wear traditional class costumes or long/short-sleeved blouses/polo tops and skirts/tunics that conform to the regular costume length. Low-cut tops and short, tight skirts are not permitted.
- 13. Make-up will not be permitted for any dancer in the first two grades (Bun Grád and Tús Grád or equivalent) up to and including the under 12 age group worldwide). Make-up (including false eyelashes) is not permitted for dancers, in either solo or team competitions, up to and including the Under 10 age group. *updated Oct.2015*
- 14. Any competitor found to be using artificial carriage aids and subsequently refuses to remove same, will be subject to disqualification from that particular competition. Medically prescribed apparatus (proof of which may be required) will be exempt from this ruling. *updated Oct* 2015
- 15. No block, en point, stationary or moving is allowed to be performed for all ages up to and including the under 12 age group. *Effective September 1, 2005*
- 16. For heavy rounds in competitions, dancers may not wear soft shoes that have been altered with the addition of heels and tips in an attempt to turn them into hard shoes. Dancers found to be wearing such altered shoes for heavy rounds may be denied access to that round of the competition. *Effective January 1, 2015*
