<u>RIALACHA</u>

- 1 Adjudicators decision is final.
- 2 Age as at 1st January 2016.
- 3 Entries only accepted from teachers registered with An Coimisiun Le Rinci Gaelacha
- 4 Make-Up (including false eyelashes and face tan) will not be permitted for all age groups up to an including Under 10.
- 5 In Bun Grad & Tus Grad, make-up will not be permitted in competitions up to and including the Under 12 age group. Dancers in all ages must wear either class costumes, skirt and blouse or ordinary civilian clothing Low cut tops or tight skirts are not permitted.
- 6 Bun Grad confined to dancers who have never won 1st prize for that particular dance in any age or grade or who have been upgraded as per Rule No. 8. Basic Steps only are permitted.
- 7 Tus Grad confined to dancers who have never won 1st prize for that particular dance in any age in Tus Grad, Lar Grad, Mean Grad or Ard Grad. Dancers may perform either basic steps or their first hard/difficult version of each dance. Steps in Tus Grad Heavy Jigs and Hornpipes must be similar to those used in St. Patricks Day and The Blackbird.
- 8 In Bun Grad competitions, one dancer moves up to next grade, if less than 30 competitors; two dancers move up to the next grade if there are between 31 and 50 competitors; and three dancers move up to next grade if there are more than 50 competitors.
- 9 Dancers may only perform a dance in Mean Grad, if they have never won 1st prize for that dance in Mean or Ard Grad in that age or a higher age.
- 10 Dances permitted in Rince Eadtrom are : Reel, Light Jig, Single Jig or Slip Jig.
- 11 Dances permitted in Rince Trom in Tus Grad are : Heavy Jig, Hornpipe or St. Patrick's Day.
- 12 Dances permitted in Rince Trom in Mean Grad are : Heavy Jig or Hornpipe.
- In Preliminary Championships, competitors must dance Reel or Slip Jig & Jig or Hornpipe.
 Dancers will be eligible to dance in Preliminary Championships if:
 a) they have never previously won an Open championship judged by 3 or more adjudicators,
 a) they have not won more than three preliminary Open championship judged by 3 or more adjudicators,
 c) they have not qualified to compete in Oireachtas Rince na Cruinne in the current or previous year.
- Dancers must perform to the following metronomic speeds:
 Bun Grad: Reel 122-124, Light Jig 116, Single Jig 124, Slip Jig 124, Heavy Jig 96, Hornpipe 144.
 Tus Grad: Reel 116-118, Light Jig 116, Single Jig 124, Slip Jig 120, Heavy Jig 82, Hornpipe 130.
 Mean Grad : Reel 113, Light Jig 116, Single Jig 124, Slip Jig 113, Heavy Jig 73, Hornpipe 113.
 Traditional Set Dances (minimum): St. Patrick's Day 94, Blackbird 144, Job of Journeywork 138, Garden of Daisies 138, King of the Fairies 130, Three Sea Captains 96, Jockey to the Fair 90.
- 15 All competitors will be required a dance a MINIMUM number of 40 bars, except in Slip Jigs, Hornpipes & Bun Grad Reels where a MINIMUM number of 32 bars will be required.
- 16 No block, en point, stationery or moving will be allowed for all ages up to and including Under 12.
- 17 Parents are responsible for the conduct and behaviour of their children at all times whilst attending the feis, within and around the hall.
- 18 Changing of costumes, dressing or undressing, is not permitted in the halls or public areas.
- 19 The Feis committee, as far as practical, will provide a surface suitable for dancing. However, the committee cannot accept any liability whatsoever for injuries sustained whilst on stage or within the practise area. The lodgment of an entry will be deemed an acceptance of this provision by a dancer and by his/her parent or guardian.
- 20 Objections must be lodged within one hour of commencement of the results of a competition and must be accompanied by a fee of €20.
- 21 Any form of unauthorised photography which has the capability to capture a dancer's image whilst in motion, using electronic or manual means e.g. mobile phone, ipads, standard camera, video camcorder, cine recorder, commercial film, with or without flash enhancement, is expressly forbidden in all competitions.
