

- 2. Entries will only be accepted from teachers currently registered with An Coimisiun le Rinci Gaelacha
- 3. Objections must be submitted in writing within one hour of the announcement of results of that competition & accompanied by a fee of £20
- 4. The feis committee will not accept any responsibility for personal injuries or articles lost at the feis
- 5. Age reckoned from 1st January 2016
- 6. All Bungrad & Tusgrad competitors must wear a class costume or appropriate day wear. They are not permitted to wear fake tan or make-up in these grades up to u12 years. Bungrad dancers must also dance basic steps
- 7. Bungrad & Tusgrad competitions are confined to dancers who have never won first prize in that particular dance in any age or grade
- 8. Meangrad is confined to dancers who have never won $\mathbf{1}_{st}$ place for that particular dance or age group either in Mean or Ard grad
- 9. No child dancing in age groups up to & including u10 years is permitted to wear tan/make up in any grade, as per An Coimisiun rule
- 10. For child protection purposes the organisation does not allow any form of unauthorised photography which has the ability to capture a child/dancers image whilst in motion
- 11. No block, en point, stationary or moving is allowed to be performed for all ages up to & including u12 age group.
- 12. All grades are open to all areas
- 13. The feis committee reserves the right to A) use a relief adjudicator, B) alternate competitions, if it becomes necessary in order to help the feis run smoothly.
- 14. A preliminary championship will be incorporated into each championship from U10 years up to, and including U16, where there is a minimum of 5 competitors eligible for the competition. To be eligible, dances must have A) never won an open championship judged by 3 or more adjudicators B) Not won 3 or more preliminary championships judged by 3 or more adjudicators, C) not qualified to compete at World Championships in 2016 or 2015
