Rules:

- 1. Adjudicators decision is final.
- 2. Objections in writing within one hour of the announcement of a result of a competition and accompanied by a fee of €20.
- 3. The feis committee will not accept any responsibility for personal injuries or articles lost at the feis.
- 4. Age will be reckoned from the 1st January 2015.
- 5. There is no smoking permitted in the hall.
- 6. Comhairle ruling: All Bungrad competitors wear a class costume or a simple skirt/top.
- 7. As and from September 2005, no block, en point, stationary or moving be allowed to be performed for all ages up to under 12 age group.
- 8. Bun Grád is confined to dancers who have never won 1st prize in that particular dance in any age or grad. (Basic steps only)
- 9. Mean Grád is confined to dancers who have never won 1st prize for that particular dance in either in Méan or Árd Grad.

Any form of unauthorised photography which has the ability to capture a dancer's image whilst in the motion is strictly forbidden.

The feis committee reserves the right to (a) use relief adjudicators, and (b) alternate competitions, if necessary in order to help the feis run more smoothly.

- 10. To be eligible for the preliminary championship competitors must have
 - (A) Never previously won an open championship competition.
 - (B) Never previously have won more than three preliminary championships judged by 3 or more adjudicators.
 - (C) Not have qualified for Oireachtas Rince na Cruinne 2014/2015/2016.
 - (D) Preliminary competitions will be from U/8 to U/16 in all girls competitions.
