RULES

- 1. The adjudicator's decision is final
- 2. Entries will only be accepted from teachers currently registered with An Coimisiúin le Rincí Gaelacha
- 3. Objections must be submitted in writing within one hour of the announcement of results of that competition & accompanied by a fee of £20.
- 4. The feis committee will not accept any responsibility for personal injuries or articles lost at the feis
- 5. Age reckoned from 1st January 2018
- 6. All Bun Grád & Tus Grád competitions are confined to dancers who have never won first prize in that particular dance in any age or grade
- 7. All Bun Grád & Tus Grád competitors must wear a class costume or appropriate day wear. They are not permitted to wear fake tan or make-up in these grades up to Under 12 years. Bun Grád dancers must also dance basic steps
- 8. Mean Grád competitions are confined to dancers who at the time of entry have never won first prize for that particular dance in Mean Grád or Ard Grád in that age group or a higher age group
- 9. No child dancing in age groups up to & including Under 10 years is permitted to wear tan or make up in any grade, as per An Coimisiúin rules
- 10. For child protection purposes the organisation does not allow any form of unauthorised photography which has the ability to capture a child/dancers image whilst in motion
- 11. No block, en point, stationary or moving is allowed to be performed for all ages up to & including Under 12 age group
- 12. All grades are open to all areas
- 13. The feis committee reserves the right to A) use a relief adjudicator, B) alternate competitions, if it becomes necessary in order to help the feis run smoothly
- 14. A preliminary championship will be incorporated into each championship from Under 8 years up to, and including Under 18 where there is a minimum of 5 competitors eligible for the competition. To be eligible, dancers must have A) never won an open championship judged by 3 or more adjudicators B) not won 3 or more preliminary championships judged by 3 or more adjudcators C) not qualified for Oireachtas Rince na Cruinne in either current or previous year.
