Any teams entered will have the option on performing their recall round outside of the competition



RULES:

- 1) The adjudicators' decision will be final.
- Objections in writing within one hour of the announcement of a result of a competition and accompanied by a fee of €20.00.
- *3)* The feis committee will not accept any responsibility for personal injuries or articles lost at the feis.
- 4) Age will be reckoned from the  $1^{st}$  January 2020.
- 5) There is no smoking permitted in the hall.
- 6) Comhairle ruling: all Bungrad competitors wear a class costume or a simple skirt/top. It is also not permissible to wear tan or make-up in these grades.
- 7) As and from September 2005, no block, en point, stationary or moving be allowed to be performed for all ages up to and including the under 12 age group.
- Bun Grád is confined to dancers who have never won 1<sup>st</sup> prize in that particular dance in any age or grade. (Basic Steps only)
- Mean Grád is confined to dancers who have never won 1<sup>st</sup> prize for that particular dance in either Méan or Árd Grad.
- 10) Any form of unauthorised photography which has the ability to capture a dancer's image whilst in motion is strictly forbidden.
- 11) If you wish your child to be excluded from any photographs that may be uploaded onto social media websites, please ensure that you inform the feis organisers in advance.
