Rialacha

- 1. Age to be taken as on 1st January, 2016.
- 2. Entries accepted only from teachers registered with An Coimisiun le Rinci Gaelacha.
- 3. The Adjudicator's decision is final. Adjudicators are to be approached by Committee members only.
- 4. Any objections must be made in writing to feis organisers within one hour, signed and accompanied by a fee of €20 which will be returned if objection is sustained.
- 5. The feis committee will not be responsible for any personal injury or articles lost at the feis. The committee, as far as practical, will provide a stage surface suitable for dancing. However, the committee cannot accept any liability whatsoever for injuries sustained while on stage. The lodgement of any entry will be deemed to be acceptance of these rules by a dancer and his/her parents/guardian.
- 6. Bungrad competitions are confined to dancers who have never won a 1st place in that specific dance and basic steps only are permitted.
- 7. Tusgrad competitions are confined to dancers who have never won 1st place in Tusgrad or Meangrad for that specific dance. Basic steps or the first difficult version of each dance only.
- 8. <u>Preliminary</u> is confined to competitors who have not been placed in the top five in an Open Championship judged by three or more Adjudicators. The winner of a Preliminary Championship automatically eliminates the dancer from dancing in grades than prelim. The dancer must not have qualified for the World Championships for the past two years, (with the exception of boys who are eligible if they qualified but did not place in the top 3 at their Oireachtas and otherwise fulfil the requirements of Prelim, or have been regraded). The dancer must not have won a Preliminary Championship three or more times with effect from 1st January 2012.
- 9. Make up, wigs or solo costumes are not permitted in the Bungrad or Tusgrad competitions.
- 10. All dancers will be required to dance a minimum of 40 bars, except slip jig and hornpipe where a minimum of 32 bars will be required.
- 11. Any form of unauthorised photography which has the ability to capture a dancer's image whilst in motion is strictly forbidden.
