The feis this year will be held on 12<sup>th</sup> and 13<sup>th</sup> November 2016. Under 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16, 16, 17, 18 and over 18 open championship and prelim championship will take place on Saturday 12<sup>th</sup> November. Under 6 and 7 championship and all grades will take place on Sunday 13<sup>th</sup> November.

We will be holding our feis in the same venue – Hightown school, Hightown, North Belfast .This venuw has excellent facilities for spectators and competitors. There will be a special covering to prevent clipping while in motion. There will be hot and cold food facilities provided.

Entries will be taken on the day but if teachers could email names by 6<sup>th</sup> November to speed up registration on the day. There is also a grade entry sheet attached if all teachers could pass to parents to bring with them when registration to speed up the entry table on the day of the grade competitions.

In open championships were there are 15 or more competitors there will be a recall for the set dance. Sashes and trophies will be awarded to  $1^{st} - 5^{th}$  place winners.

Preliminary Championships for under 10 up to and including under 16, will be in incorporated within the open championship and will be judged on round 1 and round 2. Sashes and trophies will be awarded to  $1^{st} - 3^{rd}$  place winners.

#### **FEIS RULES**

- 1. Adjudicators decision is final.
- 2. Age as at 1<sup>st</sup> January 2016.
- 3. To be eligible for the preliminary championship, a dancer must;
  - a. Not have previously won an open championship judged by 3 or more adjudicators
  - b. Not have won more than 3 preliminary championships judged by 3 or more adjudicators
  - c. Not have qualified for Oireachtas Rince na Cruinne in either 2015 or 2016.
- 4. All dancers are required to dance a minimum number of 40 bars except in Slip Jig, hornpipe and bungrad reels were a minimum of 32 bars is required.
- 5. No block, en-point, stationary or moving will be allowed for all ages up to and including under 11.
- 6. The Feis Committee reserves the right to:
  - a. Transfer competitions to a different hall
  - b. Alternate competitions if it becomes necessary
  - c. Relief an audjudicator
- 7. No recording or any form of unauthorised photography which will be able to capture a dancer performing e.g. mobile phone, cameras, cine recorder, commercial film with or without flash is strictly forbidden. Anyone who breaks this rule will be aked to leave.
- 8. Entries only accepted from teachers registered with An Comisiun Le Rinci Gaelacha.
- 9. Changing in the halls is forbidden.
- 10. Entrancer in/out of the venue will be monitored.
- 11. Objections will only be considered if lodged in writing and accompanied by a fee of £20.00.
- 12. Competitors must be ready at least 15 minutes prior to the start time of each competition.
- 13. All competitors must dance in strict order that is requested of them. Anyone missing rotation will be disqualified.
- 14. Bungrad competitions are confined to dancers who have never won 1<sup>st</sup> place in that particular dance in any age group or grade. Basic steps only.
- 15. Tusgrad competitions are confined to dancers who have never won 1<sup>st</sup> place in that particular dance in any age group in Tusgrad, Meangrad or Ardgrad.
- 16. Meangrad competitions are confined to dancers who have never won 1<sup>st</sup> place in that particular dance in Meangrad or Ardgrad in that age group or a higher age group.
- 17. Bungrad and Tusgrad makeup will not be permitted. Dancers must wear class costumes or day clothes.
- 18. All competitions are held under the rules and regulation of An Comisiun Le Rinci Gaelacha.



- Open Championship: Under 10 Over 18 = £25.00 includes solo results.
- **Preliminary Championships:** £28.00. Will be placed in both Championship and prelim if they get a recall.
- Traditional Trophy Set Dance: £5.00.
- **Grades:** £3.00 per dancer.
- Team Dance: £3.00 per dancer.Trophy Dance: £5.00 per dancer.
- Top 5 in Open Championship will receive trophies and sashes.
- Top 3 in Preliminary Championship will receive trophies and 1<sup>st</sup> place will receive a sash.
- Top 3 in trophy dances will receive trophies.
- If a prelim dancer gets a recall, they will be placed in both Championship and Prelim Championship.
