#### **Directions:**

From Dublin – take the M9 motorway all the way to Waterford. Turn left at the first roundabout (Quarry Roundabout) and left at the second roundabout (Grannagh Roundabout) which will bring you on to the N25. Follow the N25 until you reach the Luffany Roundabout and take the first exit and the Rhu Glenn Hotel is a minute's drive on the right-hand side. (1hr and 15mins from the old Red Cow Roundabout.)

From Galway, Limerick and Tipperary – Head to Waterford and when you reach the Quarry Roundabout turn right. Then turn left at the Grannagh Roundabout which will bring you on to the N25. Follow the N25 until you reach the Luffany Roundabout and take the first exit and the Rhu Glenn Hotel is a minute's drive on the right-hand side.

From Cork – Take the N24 all the way to Waterford (**ignore** signs for Waterford City). Go through the toll and cross the new bridge. Stay on the bypass and head for N25 Rosslare. Follow the N25 until you reach the Luffany roundabout and take the first exit and the Rhu Glenn Hotel is a minute's drive on the right-hand side.
