Rialacha Ginearálta An Oireachtais 2021

- **Please note that these rules and directives must be read in conjunction with the general rules and other relevant sections of this syllabus**
- All competitors:
 - Must be pupils of teachers who, at the date of entry, are registered with An Coimisiún for the year 2021/2022.
 - Must not, on the date(s) of their competition(s), be under suspension from competitive dancing due to any rule of An Coimisiún (including the ‘Transfer Rule’)

General Rules:

1. Age to be taken from the 1st January 2021.
2. Entries will not be accepted without birth certificates.
3. The **adjudicator’s decision** is final.
4. **No block, en pointe**, stationery or moving is allowed for all ages up to and including the Under 11 age group.
5. Dancing is only permitted in designated practice areas.
6. Dancers will dance in three's up to and including the under 12 championships. Dancers over 12 years will dance three at a time for their heavy round and two at a time for their light round.
7. Please note that in the event of illness or injury to any pupils prior to competing at the event, a **doctor’s certificate** should be submitted to an Runai within seven days of the closure of Oireachtas Rince na Mumhan 2021.
8. All tiaras, cups, belts and trophies **must** be returned in **good condition** to either Helan Green / Geraldine Corless or Brian Hoban – Comhairle Na Mumhan Trophy Officers.
9. In order to ensure the safety of all competitors, An Comhairle will appoint an official photographer for Oireachtas Rince na Mumhan 2021. The use of flash photography and video equipment is strictly forbidden in the interests of child protection.
10. Dancers must be in the hall, dressed and ready to dance 30 minutes prior to the commencement of competition.

11. Preliminary Championship:

(Girl’s championships 9-10, 10-11, 11-12, 12-13, 13-14, 14-15 & 15-16)

Eligibility to enter the Preliminary....

- A dancer is not eligible to enter a Preliminary Championship if they have been placed First in an Open Championship from 1st January 2020 and current year.
- Once a dancer qualifies for Oireachtas Rince na Cruinne, they must not enter a Preliminary Championship. They may not compete in Preliminary Championships in the year that they qualified or the following calendar year. This includes World Qualifiers from the All-Ireland or and Irish Nationals.
- If a dancer wins two Preliminary Championships from the 1st January, they are no longer eligible to enter a Preliminary Championships for the remainder of that year and the following year.

Exceptions

- Dancers who qualify for Oireachtas Rince na Cruinne where there are five dancers or less in their Regional Oireachtas are exempt from this ruling. They may remain in the Preliminary Championships if they so wish.
- If a dancer wins a Preliminary Championship where there are five dancers or less in the competition, the dancer will still be eligible to enter a Preliminary Championship.



Rules and Directives for Solo Competitions:

13. The required dances for each championship are set out on the Clár.

14. The heavy dance (Port Trom/Cornphíopa (Round 1) or the Set (Round 3) will be performed first in all competitions. (Exceptions: Thursday Comp #1 Priomh comórtos 5-6 and Comp #2 & #3 Craobh comórtos 6 – 7 as the required dances are light dances only)

15. Prior to the commencement of each championship, competitors will submit the name and metronomic speed of the set dance nominated by them. All set dances nominated must be on the official list.

- (a) The onus of ensuring that the stage steward is informed of the correct name and metronomic speed of the nominated open set dance will rest with the competitor.
- (b) An incorrect metronomic speed submitted for an open set dance can only be changed prior to the commencement of the playing of the relevant set dance for that competitor.
- (c) Introductions to open set dances will be played only once and no alteration in that speed of music will be permitted.
- (d) Should a competitor commence dancing to an incorrect metronomic speed submitted to the stage steward then that competitor must continue to dance at that speed as no further opportunity of tempo change will be afforded.
- (e) Competitors beginning to dance before or after the stipulated set dance introduction will automatically receive ZERO marks and ZERO points from all adjudicators for that round

16 Girls and Boys Championships Under 6 -7 -8 and 9 will dance 40 bars only after an 8 bar introduction.

17. All other Championships dancers will dance for 48 bars in the reel and jig and 40 bars in the slip jig and hornpipe after an 8 bar introduction. Dancers beginning to dance before or after the stipulated 8 bar introduction will automatically receive a ZERO for that round from all adjudicators.

18. A competitor who fails to dance or complete any round of their three rounds of the Craobh Comórtos will receive ZERO marks and ZERO points from all adjudicators for that round and **cannot place in a medal winning position or World qualifying position.**

19. A competitor who fails to dance or complete any round of their three rounds of the Craobh Comórtos will receive ZERO marks and ZERO points from all adjudicators for that round and **will not be placed in the solo result for that round but can be placed in a medal winning position of the solo results of either or both of the other two rounds.**

20. Definition of complete means that all bars as outlined in the syllabus are danced without any stops.

21. Respect for fellow competitors on stage is always a requirement. Lack of respect or courtesy for fellow competitors by aggressive dancing on stage will be subject to penalty at the discretion of each individual adjudicator.

Carriage Aids:

22.

(a) Any competitor found to be using artificial carriage aids and subsequently refuses to remove same, will be subject to disqualification from that particular competition. Medically prescribed apparatus (proof of which may be required) will be exempt from this ruling.

(b) Any competitor wearing their shoes on the wrong feet will be treated in the same manner as if using carriage aids and be subject to disqualification from that particular competition.

Objections:

23. Any objections, other than those relating to adjudicators' decisions, **must be lodged in writing with a fee of €20.00 and addressed to An Runai** prior to the announcement of the results of the particular competition concerning the objection. The fee will be returned if the objection is upheld.

Music Speeds:

24. In all solo championships the speeds of the musical accompaniment will be as per An Coimisiun Official speed. (a maximum deviation of ± 1 point will be permitted)

ORDER OF DANCING, CONDUCT, MISHAPS, etc.

25. All competitors should be advised by teachers that should a shoe, heel or toe piece come off whilst dancing, he/she should retire to the rear of the stage and remain there until the other competitors have completed their dance. In the event of this situation arising, these competitors will be permitted to dance again.

26. Where a dancer fails to complete his / her performance in any given round, that dancer is to be given ZERO marks by each adjudicator for that round.

27. Should a dancer fall, slip or bump into another dancer on stage, whether in solos or in teams, the adjudicator MUST ring the bell to stop the performance of the dancer(s). Dancers so affected will be permitted to re-dance and will be marked then at the discretion of each individual adjudicator.

28. Should in the opinion of the stage steward, having obtained medical advice, if necessary, a dancer be unfit to re-dance and if such dancer insists on his/her right to do so then the dancer concerned will only be permitted to re-dance on completion of a declaration form exonerating An Comhairle of liability for any consequences. Any repeat accident / incident which results in that dancer being unable to complete the required number of bars of any round, will result in the dancer withdrawing without question from the championship.

29. If a dancer falls during the last 8 bars of any performance, then he/she would only be required to dance the last 16 bars of that dance again at a time convenient to both dancers and stage stewards.

30. A competitor must not walk off the stage during a performance unless instructed to do so by an adjudicator. A dancer who dismisses themselves from the stage without the permission of an adjudicator will not be marked for that particular dance.

31. If at any stage during a performance on stage an adjudicator feels that due to the health and safety of a performer on stage that the performance should be stopped the adjudicator must ring the bell.

32. In the case of set dances, introductions will be played only once, and a dancer must set his/her music speed during the one playing. No variation of the speed of the music will be permitted once dancing is due to commence. The onus of ensuring that the stage steward is informed of the correct name of set dance and the correct metronomic speed will rest with the dancer. Should a dancer submit an incorrect metronomic speed to the stage steward and commence dancing at that speed, then the dancer must continue to dance at this speed as no further opportunity of tempo change will be afforded. Dancers beginning to dance before or after the stipulated set dance introduction will automatically receive a ZERO for that round from all adjudicators.

33. In all competitions, competitors must commence their dance in the first two rounds from the designated starting points. In the set dance round a competitor may choose his/her starting point.



34. Competitors must:

- (a) Obey all instructions of the Oireachtas officials, otherwise permission to compete may be withdrawn
- (b) Dance in numerical order as published in the official programme. Commencement numbers for each round of a competition will be printed in the programme.
- (c) Check-in before the time scheduled for the commencement of the championship.
- (d) Present themselves to the stage stewards in good time to dance in the appropriate numerical order otherwise the stage steward may refuse permission to dance.

35. Should a competitor or their teacher feel that there was a reasonable and convincing reason for being late they may lodge an appeal which will be immediately determined by an ad hoc sub-committee comprised of the stage steward and two other members of An Comhairle, one of whom must be an officer. The decision of the subcommittee on the matter shall be final.

36. An Comhairle will, as far as is practicable provide a stage surface suitable for dancing. However, An Comhairle cannot accept any liability for injuries sustained while on stage. The lodgment of an entry will be deemed to be an acceptance of this provision by a dancer.

Interpretations of the Rules of An Comhairle:

37.

- (a) Decisions of An Comhairle as to the interpretation of these Rules and in relation to all other matters pertaining to the Oireachtas shall be final.
- (b) The submission of an entry shall be taken to signify that the teachers and their pupils concerned accept all these Rules in full and agree to strictly abide thereby.

Qualifiers for Oireachtas Rince na Cruinne 2022

Please note that these rules and directives must be read in conjunction with the CONFINEMENT OF COMPETITIONS & QUALIFICATION section of the GENERAL RULES OF THE WORLD CHAMPIONSHIPS 2022-Rules 1 to 14 of the Syllabus of Rince Na Cruinne.

Extracted From Syllabus of Rince Na Cruinne:

9.

- (a) The number of qualifiers for Oireachtas Rince na Cruinne 2022 at a Regional or National Oireachtas shall be determined by the number of competitors from that particular qualifying region who actually dance in the event concerned and not the number entered.
- (b) In calculating the number of qualifiers from a Regional Oireachtas dancers deemed to have already qualified by having attained medal winning positions at Oireachtas Rince na Cruinne 2019 will count as competitors but not as qualifiers.
- (c) A World medal holder from Oireachtas Rince na Cruinne 2019 cannot be replaced by an additional qualifier at a National Oireachtas in 2021 or Regional Oireachtas 2021.
- (d) If a World medal holder from Oireachtas Rince na Cruinne 2019, including a world champion, does not compete at a Regional Oireachtas 2021, then an additional qualifying place is not created for Oireachtas Rince na Cruinne 2022.
- (e) Where a Regional Oireachtas does not proceed in 2021, then the rankings from the equivalent Regional Oireachtas in 2019 or 2020 will be used to determine solo qualifiers for Oireachtas Rince na Cruinne 2022.

10.

- (a) Qualifiers from a National Oireachtas 2021 or Oireachtas na hÉireann 2022 must also compete in their Regional Oireachtas 2021 to endorse this qualification. In the case of Oireachtas Rince na hÉireann 2022 qualifiers must also compete at their Primary Oireachtas.
- (b) Qualifiers from a National Oireachtas 2021 or Oireachtas na hÉireann 2020 or 2022 do not create additional qualifying places at a Regional Oireachtas 2021.

11. The number of qualifiers from the respective competitions at a Regional or National Oireachtas shall be as follows: -

- (a) In the case of competition 1 the number of qualifiers shall be seven (7) where the number of competitors is twenty or less plus one additional qualifier for each five, or part of five in excess of the first twenty eligible competitors. (see item 9)
- (b) In the case of all other solo age groups the number of qualifiers shall be five (5) where the number of competitors is twenty or less plus one additional qualifier for each ten, or part of ten in excess of the first twenty eligible competitors. (see item 9)

12. The maximum number of qualifiers for Oireachtas Rince na Cruinne 2022 from a Regional Oireachtas 2019 or 2020 or 2021 is determined by Rules 9, 10 and 11.



Comhairle Na Mumhan - Media Policy for Oireachtas Na Mumhan

CLRG Media Policy - Any form of unauthorised photography which has the capability to capture a dancer's image whilst in motion, using electronic or manual means e.g. mobile phone, standard camera, video camcorder, commercial film, with or without enhancement, is expressly forbidden. Comhairle Na Mumhan has appointed an official photographer for the Oireachtas, who will take photographs and videos of competitors, competitions and presentations. Such photographs and videos may be subsequently used for the marketing and promotional purposes of the organisation including the publication of such photographs on the official website www.munsterdancubng.com and CLRG social media outlets.

Comhairle Na Mumhan may also appoint other agents during the Championships for special promotional projects and reserves the right to permit suitably accredited photojournalists to take photographs on a case-by-case basis.

Should any dancer or dancer's parent or guardian wish to be excluded from any of these photographs, please contact any member of the Oireachtas Committee with relevant details.

PLEASE NOTE: Other than the photographs taken by the official photographer, authorised agents of Comhairle Na Mumhan or accredited photojournalists, all photographs captured at the event including images of competitors and presentations may only be taken for personal use. They may not be redistributed, sold, lent or passed on to third parties. They may also not be used for commercial purposes or used in any publication or posted to any website without the express written permission of Comhairle Na Mumhan and the parents or guardians of all dancers included in any picture.

PROFESSIONAL PHOTOGRAPHY EQUIPMENT will not be permitted inside the competition rooms except for individuals that have a valid CLRG photo pass. Attendees are not allowed to bring zoom lenses greater than 70mm inside the dance events, and no individuals will be granted access to take photographs on or near the stage during the competitions.

MEDIA APPLICATIONS: Accredited journalists may apply for event access and photo passes by contacting the Public Relations Officer at comhairlenamumhan@gmail.com. All applicants will be required to complete the necessary paperwork and be compliant with our child protection policy and all rules of CLRG. Ignoring or failing to comply with the above will lead to expulsion from the premises
