Welcome to the first ever Three Nations Championships. We are so excited to be able to host this brand new competition confined to dancers residing in England, Scotland and Wales due to take place in August 2021.

We are delighted to offer Mixed <mark>Open Championships from U</mark>nder 6 to Under 9 and Separate Boys/Mens And Girls/Ladies Open Championships from Under 10 and up. We are also offering a Preliminary Championship within the Girls/Ladies Championships U10+ and the result will be taken from 1st 2 rounds. All Championships will also have 2 solo results.

All competitors in Under 8 and Under 9 will dance all 3 rounds and we will offer a 50% recall for all championships with more than 30 competitors from Under 10 upwards. Championships from Under 10 upwards will be judged by rotating panels of 3 and the younger age groups will be adjudicated by a set panel of 3.

Our fantastic venue, Jury's Inn Hotel and Conference Centre at Hinckley offers a central location, easily accessible from all areas of the 'Three Nations' and boast the finest facilities including 362 modern bedrooms, Marco Pierre White Restaurant, Piazza Bar and Triumph Lounge. It also has a fully refurbished pool and relaxation area, fitness centre plus modern conference facilities to host our dancing competitions.

Under 6 - Under 7 Solo Championship Entry £45 (Includes Door Fee) Under 8 - Under 9 Solo Championship Entry £50 (Includes Door Fee) Under 10 – Senior Solo Championship Entry £60 (Includes Door Fee) Maximum Family fee: £150 (Includes Door fee)

The closing date for all entry fees will 18TH June.

Late entries will be accepted with double fees (up to a maximum of £400 per class) until 25th June.

PAYMENT METHOD

Lodgement of entries https://www.instepfm.com

- 1. The website for lodgement of entries is https://www.instepfm.com. The website provides clear instructions on how to complete the lodgement process. All entries must be lodged through this website and full payment made by the 18TH June 2021.
- Late entries will be accepted between 19th June 25th June 2021 (postmarked) at double the normal entry fee. NOTE: <u>No</u> entries whatsoever will be taken if postmarked after 25th June.
- 3. Following lodgement through the website, an email confirming all entries submitted and the total fee payable will immediately be sent to each applicant.
- 4. All entries MUST be paid through Bank Transfer. Please contact Des Silke to request bank details desilke@instepfm.com or desilke648@icloud.com.
- 5. Once entries are 'SUBMITTED' online they need to pay the amount on the confirmation email. If the amount on the confirmation email is not fully paid entries will not be accepted
- 6. It is the responsibility of the teacher to ensure that the entry as submitted online is correct. When the confirmation email is received, names and dates of birth must be carefully checked for Spellings etc. Details submitted by the teacher will be what appears in the official programme.
- 7. No refunds will be made for any entry money received.
- 8. ALL entries are to be paid by Sterling.

COMPETITION RULES

hese rules should be read in conjunction with rules laid out by An Coimisiun Le Rinci Galeacha.

<u>GENERAL</u>

- 1.1. Adjudicator's decision is final.
- 1.2. Committee members only may approach adjudicators.
- 1.3. Any protest against breach of rules must be made in writing to the feis organiser within one hour of conclusion of a competition, with a fee of £10.00. Should the objection be upheld the fee will be refunded.
- 1.4. Entries will only be accepted from schools registered with An Coimisiun.
- 1.5. Lodgement of entries at a feis implies that you accept the rules relating to the feis in their entirety as laid down by the An Coimisiún le Rinci Gaelacha & Midland Regional Council.

AGE GROUPS

- 1.6. Age to be taken from 1st January of the current year. Where a competitor's birthday falls on 1st January he/she shall, be regarded as under the age attained on that day.
- 1.7. Competitors must dance in their own age group for solo competitions except where there is no provision for that dance in that age group.

DANCE MOVEMENTS

1.8. Rules appertaining to Dance movements such as toe movements, metronomic speeds as laid out by An Coimisiun apply

COSTUME & MAKE-UP

- 1.9. All costume and make-up rules as set out in CLRG rules must be adhered to.
- 1.10. Adjudicators who determine a costume to be too short or to lack modesty may use the Costume Infraction (Tick Box) Program in order to flag the dancer and ensure the teacher is notified. As the Costume Infraction Program is used for ALL costume violations, adjudicators wishing to specify length as the infraction can write the letter 'L' in the Tick Box column.
- 1.11. Under no circumstances should dancers walk around any dancing venue in their underwear. Neither should dancers (regardless of age) change in to or out of costume in the main dancing hall, if at all possible. At all times, dancers should be properly attired.
- 1.12. Make-up, including false eyelashes and tan on face, is not permitted for any dancer in the competitions up to and including the under 10 age group. Leg tan is NOT part of this rule.

MEDIA POLICY

Any form of unauthorised photography, which has the capability to capture a dancer's image whilst in motion, using electronic or manual means e.g. mobile phone, standard camera, video camcorder, commercial film, with or without enhancement, is expressly forbidden during competitions.

CARRIAGE AIDS

- 1.13. Any competitor found to be using artificial carriage aids and subsequently refuses to remove same, will be subject to disqualification from that particular competition. Medically prescribed apparatus (proof of which may be required) will be exempt from this ruling.
- 1.14. Any competitor wearing their shoes on the wrong feet will be treated in the same manner as if using carriage aids and be subject to disqualification from that particular competition.
- 1.15. In order to comply with health and safety measures, all dancers lining up side stage prior to any round of a competition will be required to perform the simple exercise of raising arms to shoulder level unhindered. If unable to do this due to costume stitching or arm attachments, by the time of their rotation, these dancers will not be permitted to perform.

ORDER OF DANCING, CONDUCT, MISHAPS ETC

- 1.16. Should a dancer lose a heel or a complete shoe or have an open lace he/she may stand back – allowing the other dancer(s), where applicable, to continue dancing uninhibited. In such a case, the dancer concerned will be permitted to re-dance as soon as it is deemed practicable by the stage steward.
- 1.17. Should a dancer fall on stage, whether in solos or in teams, the adjudicator MUST ring the bell to stop the performance of the dancer(s). Dancers so affected will be permitted to redance and will be marked then at the discretion of each individual adjudicator. If a dancer falls during the last 8 bars of any performance, then he/she would only be required to dance the last 16 bars of that dance.
- 1.18. Should a dancer slip, bump into another dancer or have a costume malfunction, the bell will be rung at the discretion of the adjudicators to stop the performance of the dancer(s). Dancers so affected will be permitted to re-dance and will be marked then at the discretion of each individual adjudicator.
- 1.19. Where a dancer fails to complete his / her performance in any given round, that dancer will automatically receive ZERO marks from all adjudicators for that round.
- 1.20. Competitors beginning to dance before or after the stipulated set dance introduction will automatically receive ZERO marks from all adjudicators for that round.
- 1.21. A competitor must not walk off the stage during a performance unless instructed to do so by an adjudicator. A dancer who dismisses themself from the stage without the permission of an adjudicator will not be marked for that particular dance.

Preliminary Championships

Preliminary Championships are included in ALL Girls/Ladies Open Championships from 9-10 years upwards provided that there are 2 or more eligible dancers.

Rules for entry to the Preliminary Championship

- The first age group for a Preliminary Championship is Under 10.
- Where a Preliminary Championship is combined with an Open Championship, then the result should be taken from eligible dancers' ranking after the first two rounds.
- Due to Covid-19 restrictions, and until further notice, please note the following; All dancers, who are included on the official confirmed list of qualifiers for Oireachtas Rince na Cruinne 2022, are not eligible to compete in Preliminary Championships until further notice. This excludes dancers that automatically qualify at their Regional or National Oireachtas due to lack of numbers.
- For grading purposes, two wins will be taken as being in any two year rolling period. Where a dancer does not win a second Preliminary within two years of winning their first Preliminary Championship, then the first win will be deemed as having expired and the dancer starts afresh.
- Where there are less than 6 in a Preliminary Championship that win will not normally be considered for grading purposes. However, where a dancer wins three Preliminary Championships regardless of the number of competitors in each competition, that dancer must dance in Open Championship for a period of 12 months thereafter.
- Dances performed in a Preliminary Championships do not count for grading in solo competitions.
- Competitors that qualify for and compete in Oireachtas Rince na Cruinne in the previous 12 months cannot compete in a Preliminary Championship except where the dancer auto qualified at their Regional or National Oireachtas due to lack of numbers.
- Dancers placing 1st-3rd in an Open Championship with up to 20 competitors or 1st-5th in an Open Championship with more than 20 Competitors CANNOT compete in a Preliminary Championship for a period of 12 month.
