Dear Teachers, Parents and Dancers

We are delighted to welcome you all to the 2nd Connemara Championships which is being held in the heart of Galway at the Clayton Hotel on the 24th and 25th September.

We will be running 4 floors/stages on Saturday for grade competitions while we will have a large championship stage to accommodate all our championship competitions. There will be a prelim for all competitions from U9 to U16.

For any championship with 15 or less competitors, there will be 100% recall. Any competition which has more than 15 dancers will be a 50% recall with a separate competition for non-recalled sets. We will also have 4 entry tables on the Saturday morning (8am opening) to ensure entries for grades run as smoothly as possible. All competitions will start at 9am sharp.

- Perpetual Cup for Championship Winners
- Trophy and Sash for top 5 in Championships and Prelim
- Medal for every dancer in all reel competitions
- Trophy and Sash for top 5 in all Priomh Comortas
- Additional traditional set dance competition from u10 upwards
- Entries on the day

The venue also has ample changing facilities, and free parking.

Feis Rules

- Entries will only be accepted from teachers registered with An Coimisiún le Rincí Gaelacha.
- Age will be reckoned from 1st January 2016.
- Bungrád competitions are confined to those who have never won a first prize in that particular dance in any age group. Only basic steps may be performed.
- Túsgrád competitions are confined to dancers who have not won a first prize in that particular dance in Túsgrád, Meángrád or Ardgrád.
- Competitors in Bungrád and Túsgrád may only wear class costume, dress or skirt and top and, as per Connacht Rules, the use of make-up, fake tan and wigs is not permissible.
- Meangrad competitions are confined to dancers who have not won a first prize in that particular dance in Meángrád or Ardgrád.
- No block, en-pointe work, stationary or moving, is allowed to be performed in all ages up to and including Under 11.
- For heavy rounds in competitions, dancers may not wear soft shoes that have been altered with the addition of heels and tips in an attempt to turn them into hard shoes. Dancers found to be wearing such altered shoes for heavy rounds may be denied access to that round of the competition.
- Preliminary championships eligibility:
 - A dancer must not have placed top five in any open championship judged by three or more adjudicators
 - A dancer must not have won three or more preliminary championships
 - A dancer must not have qualified for Oireachtas Rince na Cruinne 2016 or 2017.
- The use of camcorders or mobile phone videoing is not permitted during dancing.
- The feis committee will not accept any responsibility for personal injury or damage to property on the premises.
- Objections, accepted from registered teachers only, must be lodged within one hour of the announcement of the competitio0n result and accompanied by a €20 fee.
