RIALACHA

1. Adjudicators decision is final.
2. Age as of January 1st 2019
3. Entries only accepted from teachers registered with an CLRG
4. Make-up (including false eyelashes & face tan) will not be permitted for all age-groups up to and including U10.
5. In Bun Grad & Tus Grad, make-up will not be permitted in competitions up to and including U12 age group. Dancers in all ages must wear class costumes, skirt & blouse or ordinary civilian clothing. Low cut tops or tight skirts will not be permitted.
6. Bun Grad confined to dancers who have never won 1st prize for that particular dance in any age or grade or who have been regraded as per rule number 8. Basic steps only are permitted.
7. Tus Grad confined to dancers who have never won 1st prize for that particular dance in any age in Tus Grad, Lar grad, Mean grad or Ard grad or who have been regraded as per rule number 8. Dancers may perform either basic steps or their first hard/difficult version of each dance. Steps in Tus grad heavy jigs & hornpipes must be similar to those used in St Patrick's Day or The Blackbird.
8. RE-GRADING OF DANCERS:
 - a. LESS THAN 20 DANCERS IN COMPETITION – 1 DANCER MOVES UP TO NEXT GRADE
 - b. 21- 40 DANCERS IN COMPETITION – 2 DANCERS MOVE UP TO NEXT GRADE
 - c. OVER 40 DANCERS IN COMPETITION – 3 DANCERS MOVE UP TO NEXT GRADE
9. Dancers may only perform a dance in Mean Grad if they have never won first prize for that dance in Mean or Ard grad in that age or a higher age. However, a dancer who has won a particular dance in a higher age in the previous year, may dance that dance again in mean grad in the next calendar year in their own or a higher age-group. A dancer who wins a prelim championship may not dance those dances in Mean grad for the remainder of that calendar year.
10. Dances permitted in 'Light Trophy' are Reel, Light Jig, Single Jig or Slip Jig.
11. Dances permitted in 'Heavy Trophy' in Tus Grad are Heavy Jig, Hornpipe or St Patrick's Day.
12. Dances permitted in 'Heavy Trophy' in Mean Grad are Heavy Jig or Hornpipe.
13. In Preliminary Championships competitors must dance Reel or Slip Jig **and** Jig or Hornpipe. To be eligible for the preliminary championship, dancers must have:-
 - a) never previously won an open championship judged by 3 or more adjudicators.
 - b) not won 3 preliminary championships judged by 3 or more adjudicators.
 - c) not qualified to compete in Oireachtas Rince na Cruinne in the current calendar year or are a Wold Medal holder.
- Preliminary championship Results will be based on 2 rounds.**
14. Dancers must perform to the following metronomic speeds-
Bun Grad Reel (122-124) Light Jig (116) Single Jig (124) Slip Jig (124) Heavy Jig (96) Hornpipe (144)
Tus Grad Reel (116-118) Light Jig (116) Single Jig (124) Slip Jig (120) Heavy Jig (82) Hornpipe (130)
Mean Grad Reel (113) Light Jig (116) Single Jig (124) Slip Jig (113) Heavy Jig (73) Hornpipe (113)
Trad Set dances (minimum speeds) St Patrick's Day (94) Blackbird (144) Job of Journeywork (138) Garden of Daisies (138) King of the Fairies (130) Three Sea Captains (96) Jockey to the Fair (90).
15. No block, en pointe, stationary or moving will be allowed for ages up to and including u12.
16. Objections must be lodged within 1 hour of commencement of the results of a competition and must be accompanied by a fee of €20.
17. Any form of unauthorised photography which has the capability to capture a dancers' image whilst in motion, using electronic or manual means e.g. mobile phone, iPad, tablet, standard camera, video camcorder, cine recorder, commercial film with or without flash enhancement is expressly forbidden in all competitions.
