Rialacha:

- 1. The Adjudicator's decision is final.
- 2. Age is reckoned from 1st January 2016.
- 3. Entries will only be accepted from teachers currently registered with "An Coimisiún le Rincí Gaelacha".
- 4. In Bungrad and Tusgrad make-up will not be permitted and dancers must wear either class costumes or "day clothes".
- 5. Bungrad is confined to dancers who have never won 1st prize for that particular dance in any age group or grade. Basic steps only are permitted.
- 6. Tusgrad is confined to dancers who have never won 1st prize for that particular dance in any Tus grad, Mean grad or Ard grad competition. Dancers may perform basic steps or first hard version of each dance. Steps in Tus grad Heavy Jig or Hornpipe must be similar to those used in St. Patrick's Day or Blackbird.
- 7. Mean grad is confined to dancers who have never won 1st prize for that particular dance and age group in either Mean grad or Ard grad.
- 8. A preliminary championship will be incorporated into each Ard grád Championship from Under 8 up to and including 15-16 years where there is a minimum of 5 competitors eligible for the Preliminary Championship. To be eligible for the Preliminary Championship dancers must have
- Never previously won an open championship judged by 3 or more adjudicators.
- Not have won 3 or more preliminary championships judged by 3 or morc adjudicators and
- Not have qualified for Oireachtas Rince na Cruinne in 2014, 2015 or 2016.

The Preliminary championship result will be taken after the first two rounds of each championship. Dancers recalled for the Set Dance will be included in results for both Ard grád and Preliminary Championships. Dancers to be included in the Preliminary Championship must be ticked on the entry form on submission. Dancers who do not recall for the overall Ard grád result will dance their set dance in another hall and receive a separate result for this dance. Dancers may dance Traditional Set Dance as part of this competition.

- 9. No block, en point movements, stationery or moving allowed for all ages up to and including the Under 12 age group.
- 10. All dancers will be required to dance a minimum of 40 bars except slip jig and hornpipe where a minimum of 32 bars will be required.
- 11. Any form of unauthorised photography which has the ability to capture a dancer's image whilst in motion, using electronic or manual means e.g. mobile phones, standard camera, video camcorder etc. is strictly forbidden.
- 12. Make-up (including false eyelashes and tan on the face) is not permitted for dancers in either solo or team competitions up to and including the Under 10 age group.
