- **Dancers who have previously won the Reserve Premiership or the NSW State Championships are NOT eligible to enter the Reserve Premiership however are welcome to enter the graded sections.**
- The timetable will be distributed to all teachers and posted on the AIDA NSW Facebook Page as soon as possible after the closing date. Where possible on the day of the competition the organising committee will adhere to these times.
- A program will be available on the day. No competitor numbers will be called out for sections.
- No videoing or photography is allowed whilst competitors are dancing on the stage. Videoing of beginner and primary competitors only is permitted.
- Although all care will be taken by the Association to provide a safe stage surface, all dancers participate at their own risk.
- Competitors/attendees travelling to or from the competition via any means do so at their own risk.
- Rules of Venue (Camden Civic centre) will apply for the duration of the competition; parents are to be responsible for their children for the duration of the competition. Children under 18 years must be supervised by an adult at all times.

COVID19 – Safety Plan

The 2021 AIDA NSW Grade & Reserve Premiers Feis, held at Camden Civic Centre will be held in accordance with Government regulations ensuring safety for our staff and course attendees.

AIDA NSW. reserves the right to amend this syllabus to facilitate COVID 19 restrictions. It is only by working together with a flexible, understanding and co-operative outlook, that this event can take place.

At the time of the syllabus being released it is anticipated that there is a high possibility of some sort of social distancing requirement still being in place during the course of the Event. This could result in a maximum number of attendees being admitted into competition arenas at any one time and determine a finite number of people allowed to accompany any one competitor. Attendees should keep this in mind entering.

Although it is hoped that all competitions will run as per the syllabus, it should be noted that due to possible on-going social distancing requirements that may still be in effect at the time of the event, adjustments to the syllabus may be required.

These may include but not restricted to:

- Restricted access to competition halls for non-competitors
- Restricted facilities available, including practise and warm up areas, vendors and food and beverage outlets
- Possible changes to Result and Presentation procedures

At all times, AIDA NSW. will closely observe and follow advice from the NSW State Government and relevant authorities. All attendees will be required to follow all social distancing policies and directives that will be in place during the Event.

Everyone attending will be required to provide contact details for Covid-19 tracing purposes using the QR check in code provided.

We will have Sanitizing bottles available for use and ask that all personnel wash your hands with soap and/or sanitise your hands regularly.

Further to this dancers are encouraged not to share things such as sock glue or make up.

Please follow all directions and signage at the venue.

Appointed Covid Marshalls will be present during the event and if at any time you are found to not be obeying the Covid Guidelines in place you will be ejected from the venue.

Do not attend if you or anyone in your household is are unwell for any reason, if you or someone with whom you had contact with has a known or suspected case on COVID-19 even if you are asymptomatic, or:

- have been asked by someone else to self-isolate
- have any cold or flu-like symptoms
