#### <u>RULES</u>

- 1. The adjudicators' decision will be final.
- Entries will be accepted from teachers currently registered with "An Coimisiún le Rincí Gaelacha" and names for Open Championships are to be forwarded to Orla Mc Cafferty by Friday 6<sup>th</sup> September. Entries received after the date will be charged an extra €2 per entry.
- 3. Age will be reckoned from the 1st January 2019.
- 4. Objections must be submitted in writing within one hour of the announcement of the result of that particular competition and accompanied by a fee of €20.00.
- 5. The Committee reserve the right to move competitions to Hall B to enable the smooth running of the event.
- 6. Bun Grád and Tus Grád comp
- 7. For Child Protection purposes the CLRG does not allow any form of unauthorized photography which has the ability to capture a child/dancer's image whilst in motion.
- 8. Effective from September 2005, no block, en point, stationary or moving is allowed to be performed for all ages up to and including the under 12 age group.
- 9. Effective from 1<sup>st</sup> March 2014 make-up and false eyelashes are not permitted for dancers in either solo or team competitions up to and including the under 10.
- 10. Effective from 1st January 2015. For heavy rounds in competitions, dancers may not wear soft shoes that have been altered with the addition of heels and tips in an attempt to turn them into hard shoes. Dancers found to be wearing such altered shoes for heavy rounds may be denied access to that round of the competition.
- 11. The feis committee will not accept any responsibility for personal injuries or articles lost at the feis.
- 12. Preliminary championships eligibility a dancer must not have placed top 5 in an open championship judged by 3 or more adjudicators. a dancer must not have won 3 or more preliminary championships a dancer must not have qualified for Oireachtas Rince na Cruinne 2018 or 2019
- 13. In Ard Grad championships, cups and sashes will be presented to winners from 1st to 5th place & Pre Lim is 1st to 3rd place.
- 14. A Pre-Lim result will be given from Under 9 up to and including Under 16, please ensure that the dancer is entered as Pre-Lim before the competition starts. The result will be taken after the first two rounds of each championship.
- 15. There will be a separate male competition if there are 5 or more boys entered in championships 7-8 and upwards.
