IMPORTANT NOTICE

The McAleer Open Championship Committee, reserves the right to amend this syllabus to facilitate COVID 19 restrictions.

At the time of the syllabus being released, it is anticipated that there is a possibility of some sort of social distancing requirement still being in place during the course of the event. Attendees should keep this in mind when making travel arrangements.

- Although it is hoped that all competitions will run as per the syllabus, it should be noted that due to possible on-going social distancing requirements that may still be in effect at the time of the event, adjustments to the syllabus may be required. We may also need to implement the following:
- Restricted access to the theatre for non-competitors
- Restricted facilities available, including practise and warm up areas, vendors and food and beverage outlets
- Possible changes to Result and Presentation procedures

We will closely observe and follow advice from the Victorian State Government and relevant authorities.

All attendees will be required to follow all social distancing policies and directives that will be in place during the Championships.

The McAleer Open Championship has a NO REFUND policy on all entries paid, with the exception of governmental regulations prohibiting an individual from travelling to the event. 

COVIDSafe Plan

All attendees will be required to check in via the QR code provided.

Anyone who is unwell should not attend. Any person with cold or flu symptoms, fever, runny nose etc., may have their temperature checked and be refused entry.

Posters detailing correct hand hygiene, cough etiquette and social distancing requirements will be displayed throughout the venue (DHHS). Hand sanitiser will be supplied and should be used on entry to the venue.

Social distancing will be enforced in line with Government restrictions. Dancers are requested to arrive with hair and makeup done.


The number of attendees per session will be restricted in line with government restrictions. Two spectators per dancer will be provided with wrist bands and reserved seating for the relevant session. Each session will be danced and completed, and awards presented. Dancers and parents will then be asked to leave the venue, so that the next group can be admitted.

Use of separate entry & exit points will be strictly adhered to.

Flooring will be cleaned, and all high touch surfaces will be disinfected between sessions.

A Health and Safety (COVID-safe) Officer will be appointed to ensure all policies are implemented.

Pre Bun (Pre Beginner) Premierships (3, 4 & 5 years only)	Any two Bun (beginner) grade light dances. 32 bars only. Same dance can be repeated.
Bun (Beginner) Premierships	Any two Bun (beginner) grade light dances.
Tus (Primary) Premierships	Any two Tus (primary) grade light dances.
Mean (intermediate Premierships)	Choice Reel or Slip Jig, Choice Traditional Setdance
Adult A	Any two Bun (beginner) grade light dances.
Adult B	Choice Reel or Slip Jig, Choice Traditional Setdance

- Pre Bun: For dancers aged 4 or 5 on January 1st 2021.
- Adult A: For dancers over the age of 18 years who did not take Irish dance classes as a
 juvenile
- Adult B: dancers over the age of 18 years who have taken more than 5 years off with no Irish dance competition.
- All speeds are as per AIDA Inc grading rules



RULES OF THE 2021 MCALEER OPEN CHAMPIONSHIP

This Championship is conducted under the Rules and Regulations of An Coimisiun le Rince Gaelacha and the Australian Irish Dancing Association Inc. (AIDA Inc.)

RULES

In order for entries to be accepted teachers must note that all Competitors:

- must be pupils of teachers who at the date of entry are registered with An Coimisiun for the year 2021 dancing year
- must not on the date(s) of their competition(s) be ineligible to compete due to any rule.
- must have been formally entered and have had their entry fees paid in full in due time in accordance with these rules and the General Rules of the Organising Committee.

LODGEMENT OF ENTRIES

- ENTRIES CLOSE 10:00PM FRIDAY MAY 14TH 2021
- All competitors must be entered online via http://www.trybooking.com/BQQJS
 Entries received after the due date will be treated as late for 7 days only, and will be charged a late fee of double the total entry fee. Entries cannot be accepted after May 21st, 2021

PRELIMINARY CHAMPIONSHIPS - RULES AND DIRECTIVES

- 1. Preliminary Championships will be offered in the girls sections from 9 Years of age on January 1st 2021.
- 2. Preliminary Championship will be danced as part of the Open Championship.
- 3. Entry to the Preliminary Championships will be restricted to the following –
- Dancers who have never won an Open Championship
- Dancers who did not attain a top ten position at a National Championships for 2019.
- 4. Preliminary Championship result would be calculated on the first 2 rounds of the Open Championship only, awarding top five with a prize ratio of 1:2 thereafter e.g. if there were 10 Prelim. entries in the Under 12s Girls, only 5 Places for Preliminary Championships would be awarded.
- 5. Dancers cannot enter the Preliminary Championship unless they have entered the Open Championships in the same age group.



RULES OF THE 2021 MCALEER OPEN CHAMPIONSHIP CONT.

AGE LIMITS

The age of a competitor shall be taken as on 1st January 2021. Where a competitor's birth date falls on 1st January he/she shall, for the McAleer Championship be regarded as under the age attained on that day.

PRIZES

In all Championship sections, all dancers will be recalled and in sections with 11 or more dancers, 60% of those dancers will receive a placing, whilst the remaining 40% will receive a Championship award.

In all Premierships sections, 60% of dancers will be placed in every section. Dancers with 5 or less competitors will all be placed.

Premierships with 3 or less competitors will be combined with another age group. This does not apply to Pre Bun premierships.



ORDER OF DANCING, CONDUCT, MISHAPS Competitors must:

- Obey all instructions of the Organising Committee otherwise permission to dance will be withdrawn.
- Dance in numerical order as published in the official program.
- The organising committee has the right to commence a Championship not more than 30 minutes prior to the scheduled commencement time.
- Except for the first section of the day, dancers must be in costume and ready to dance not less than 30 minutes prior to the time scheduled for their competition.
- Present to the marshalling area when called to do so by Stage Personnel. Sections will only be called for ONCE.
- Should a dancer lose a heel or a complete shoe or have an open lace, he/she may stand back, allowing the other dancer(s), where applicable, to continue dancing uninhibited. In such a case the dancer concerned will be permitted to re-dance as soon as it is deemed practicable by the stage personnel.
- No liability is accepted by the organising committee for any injury caused to any person, including but not limited to, competitors, however caused and whether or not caused by the negligence or default of the organising committee, its servants or agents. The lodgement of an entry will be deemed to be an acceptance of this provision.
- Should a dancer fall, slip or bump into another dancer on stage, whether in solos or in teams, the adjudicator
- MUST ring the bell thereby stopping the performance of all dancers on stage.
 Dancers so affected will be permitted to redance and will be marked then at the discretion of each individual adjudicator.
- Should in the opinion of the Stage Personnel (in consultation if deemed necessary
 with medical personnel) a dancer be unfit to re-dance, and if such dancer insists on
 performing the dancer concerned will only be permitted to re-dance on
 completion of a formal declaration which removes the organising committee of any
 liability. Any repeat accident/ incident which results in that dancer being unable to
 complete the required number of bars in any round, will result in the dancer
 withdrawing without question from the championship.
- If a dancer falls during the last 8 bars of any performance, then he/she will only be required to dance the last 16 bars of that dance again at a time convenient to both the dancers and the stage stewards.



ORDER OF DANCING, CONDUCT, MISHAPS cont. Competitors must:

- A competitor must not walk off the stage during a performance unless instructed to do so by an adjudicator. A dancer who dismisses himself or herself from the stage without the permission of an adjudicator will not be marked for that particular dance.
- If at any stage during a performance on stage an adjudicator feels that, due to the
 health and safety of a performer on stage that the performance should be
 stopped, the adjudicator must ring the bell.
- Respect for fellow competitors on stage is a requirement always. Lack of respect or courtesy for fellow competitors by aggressive dancing on stage will be subject to penalty at the discretion of each individual adjudicator.
- The light rounds from 10 yrs. upwards will be danced 2 at a time and the heavy rounds will be danced 2 at a time from 10 yrs. upwards if time permits. All other age groups will dance 3 at a time.

McALEER CHAMPIONSHIP PHOTOGRAPHY POLICY

No cameras, tape recorders, video cameras, mobile phones cameras, pagers or mobile phones are to be used by members of the audience. Under Government copyright, privacy and safety laws all unauthorised recording of sound and image is strictly prohibited. Any offender will be requested to leave the audience and delete illegally copied sound/vision.
