Dancers must dance at least 3 dances in their section
(with the exception of under 6 Bun where they may only dance 2).

Dancers may also compete in more than one section, dancing at least 3 dances in each.

All dancers will be placed in the Reel and Trophy Dance competitions.

All grade dance winners will receive a riser.

Top 5 dancers in Trophy dance competitions will receive a trophy and sash.

ENTRY PROCESS

Please follow the link and fill out all relevant information, this will then take you to a payment option. All entries must be pre-entered, no entries will be taken on the day.

Entries will open on **15th September at 9am** and will close when entry spaces are filled. There is a cap of 25 dancers per grade.

Entry Fees: £4 per dance, £5 per trophy dance, £5 parent admission fee

Entry for the feis indicates that dancers and their parent/guardian agree to adhere to the feis and venue guidelines.

Fees are non-refundable except in the case that the event does not go ahead as planned.

RUNNING OF THE FEIS

Dancers will be permitted **one adult** with them at any one time. There will be no other spectators, apart from teachers. Face coverings are to be worn by persons (over the age of 12) except dancers while performing or anyone with a medical exemption.

Attendees will have their temperature checked and anyone with a temperature of 38 degrees Celcius or higher cannot be admitted. Attendees will be asked to sanitise their hands at the sanitisation station beside the door and several stations will be available at the feis.

Dancers will then receive their competitor number at the entry desk. Accompanying adults will provide contact tracing information and also sign a waiver at this point - a copy of which is included later in this syllabus.

Attendees will sit in socially distanced stations of chairs in the hall. Dancers should arrive with shoes on and ready to dance. Changing is permitted in the toilets area and in the hall, only if it is guaranteed that this is done in an appropriate manner. Any missed rotations may result in disqualification.

Dancers, when called, will line up sidestage on the socially distanced marks. They will perform their rounds two at a time, take a short bow and walk off. Stage hands will assist in this process. The music will stop and the next dancers will then walk on stage.

SAFETY RULES AND INFORMATION

St. Anthony's Feis will run in accordance with NI government guidelines which can be found in full on the NI Direct website at: <https://www.nidirect.gov.uk/campaigns/coronavirus-covid-19>



By entering the feis you agree to:

- Sanitise your hands often - several stations will be available in the halls
- Stay at least 2 metres apart from those not in your group
- Wear a face covering if you are not competing
- Comply with all contact tracing procedures
- Arrive at your assigned time and be prepared to dance at your assigned times
- Follow the one-way system which will be clearly marked

Other safety measures in place:

- Online entry and payment eliminates the need for cash handling on the day
- Temperature checks at the door on entry
- All surfaces will be sanitised between each group entering the hall by cleaners
- Toilets will be sanitised regularly throughout the day by cleaners
- Strictly only one accompanying adult per dancer - no exceptions
- If there are falls or sickness on stage, only the accompanying adult will be permitted to assist
- No contact in presentations of awards
- Risk assessment required by law has been carried out and will be on display at the feis
- Separate entry and exit points

If you have a temperature, sore throat, headache, loss of taste, loss of smell, etc. you should NOT attend the feis. Please note that anyone who refuses to comply with the rules of the feis will be asked to leave, in the interest of the safety of all attendees of the feis.

RULES

1. The adjudicators decision is final.
2. Age reckoned from 1st January 2021.
3. Objections in writing within one hour of the announcement of results for that competition and accompanied by a fee of £20.
4. The feis committee will not accept any responsibility for personal injuries or articles lost at the feis.
5. For child protection purposes the organisation does not allow any form of unauthorized photography that has the ability to capture a dancer's image whilst in motion.
6. All bungrad and tusgrad competitors must wear a class costume or appropriate day wear.
7. In Bun and Tus grad, make-up will not be permitted up to and including U12 age group.
In Mean grad, make- up and tan is not permitted up to and including U10 age group, as per An Coimisiun rule.
8. Bungrad dancers must do basic steps.
9. Bungrad and tusgrad competitions are confined to dancers who have never won first place in that particular dance, in any age or grade.
10. Meangrad is confined to dancers who have never won first place for that particular dance meangrad or ardgrad in that age or a higher age.
11. No block / en pointe, stationary or moving is allowed to be performed for all ages up to and including under 12.
12. Dances permitted in **Light Trophy Dance** – Reel, Light Jig, Single Jig or Slip Jig.
13. Dances permitted in **Heavy Trophy Dance** – Heavy Jig, Hornpipe, St. Patrick's Day, The Blackbird or Job of Journeywork.
14. The feis committee reserves the right to transfer results to a different hall and alternate competitions if it becomes necessary in order to help the feis run smoothly.
15. Re-grading of dancers: 5-30 competitors -1 dancer regraded, 31-50 competitors -2 dancers regraded, 50+ competitors - 3 dancers regraded.
16. Music will be played at the following speeds:
Bungrad: Reel 122-124, Light Jig 116, Single Jig 124. **Tusgrad:** Reel 116-118, Light Jig 116, Single Jig 124, Slip Jig 120, Heavy Jig 82. **Meangrad:** Reel, Slip Jig & Hornpipe 113, Single Jig 124, Heavy Jig 73. **Traditional Set Dances:** St. Patrick's Day 94, Blackbird 144, Job of Journeywork 138.
17. If you wish your child to be excluded from any photographs that maybe uploaded onto social media websites, please ensure that you inform the feis organisers in advance.

In advance of attending the feis we require you to carefully consider the following agreement as your/your child's entry will be determined on the signing of same.

ACKNOWLEDEMENT OF PANDEMIC

I am aware that the World Health Organisation and other governmental and health authorities have declared Covid-19 a pandemic. I am aware that social distancing is to be practiced and that any increased social contact during this pandemic poses an increased risk of transmissions which could cause injury, illness or death.

CONFIRMATION OF HEALTH AND NON-TRAVEL

I confirm that I (or on behalf of the participant) am in good health and have not travelled internationally in the past 14 days and will inform my teachers, who will inform the feis organisers, should they plan to travel abroad.

ACKNOWLEDEGEMENT AND VOLUNTARY ASSUMPTION OF RISK

I am aware that other persons may attend the feis and may have been exposed to the Covid-19 virus. I am aware of the risks, dangers and hazards associated with attending the feis at this time and I (or on behalf of the participant) freely accept and fully assume all such risks, dangers and hazards and the possibility of personal injury, illness or loss resulting there from. I am aware that I (or on behalf of the participant) may require first aid, which may require 'hands-on' care and social distancing may not be possible in this instance.
