Preliminary Championships: (8-9 up to 14-15)

These competitions are confined to competitors who have not been placed in the top 5 in an Open Championship judged by 3 or more adjudicators. Winning a Preliminary Championship automatically eliminates the dancer from competing in grades lower than Prelim. The dancer must not have qualified for the Worlds in 2014 or 2015 (with the exception of the boys who are eligible if they qualified but were not placed in the top 3 at their Regional Oireachtas and who otherwise fulfill the Prelim criteria) and the dancer must have not recalled in the actual Championship at the All-Ireland 2014 or 2015. Competitors may only win a Preliminary Championship three times in a lifetime.

Concessions: *****

At Ballyhaunis Feis we have always throughout the years, acknowledged the contribution that families have made to this Feis. We do not have a family rate as such, but at the Entry Table a close eye is kept on individual cases and concessions will always be made (on the grade day) where the fee for a family is thought to be excessive.(Teachers may contact Ann prior to feis to arrange this) only one Priomh Comortas per family member will be taken into consideration when calculating fee.

Rules

1. Age to be taken from 1st January this year.
2. Bun, Tus and Mean grades are OPEN to all regions.
3. Competitors in Bun and Tus grades are not allowed to use fake tan or make-up, nor are they permitted to wear bun wigs, full wigs or solo costumes. Dancers from regions outside of Connacht must also respect and abide by this rule, even though such a rule may not exist in the area they belong to.
- 4a. Bungrad competitions are confined to competitors who have never won 1st place for the dance specified in any registered competition, in any other grade or under any age limit. In the Priomh Chomortas the light dances to be danced must have already been danced today therefore they will dance them twice.
5. Tusgrad competitions are confined to competitors who have never won 1st place in the dance specified in Tusgrad, Meangrad or Ardgrad in any age group in a registered competition. In the Priomh Chomortas in Tus the light dances they choose must have been danced in that grade today.
6. Meangrad competitions are confined to competitors who have never previously won 1st place in Meangrad or Ardgrad in any other registered competition for the dance specified for that competition or in any Championship or Priomh Chomortas under the maximum age limit specified for that dance.
7. In Meangrad Championships (Priomh Chomortas) dancers are required to dance a heavy jig or hornpipe or traditional set plus any Light Dance. The light dance they choose must have already been danced today and if their choice is to dance a heavy jig or a hornpipe this must have already been danced in Meangrad today. They must of course be meangrad in the traditional set also should they choose to dance that.
8. The committee will take no responsibility for any loss or damage to property.
9. Photography: As per Coimisiún ruling "The use of any form of unauthorized photography which has the capacity of capturing a dancer's image while in motion is strictly forbidden in competition." Any person found in breach of this rule will be asked to leave the competition hall.
10. The Adjudicator's decision is final.
11. The committee are providing a CHAMPIONSHIP STAGE, however, the committee cannot accept any liability whatsoever for injuries sustained while on stage. The lodgment of an entry will be deemed to be acceptance of this provision by the dancer and his/her parent/guardian.

Seamus Forde Memorial Cup....Perpetual Cup

The competition is open to any dancer from 8 to 9 and upwards to 10 to 11. They can be **any grade meangrad or lower** but they must have already entered their relevant grades today, including the meangrad competitions which immediately follow this competition spot. The 1st 10 children will receive a sash. All competitors will receive a medal. All will dance St. Pat. Day. **Confined to children resident in Connacht and attending class in Connacht.**
