RIALACHA NA FEILE – RULES

Entries will only be accepted from teachers currently registered with An Coimisún le rinci Galacha

Objections must be lodged in writing within one hour of the announcement of a competition & be accompanied by a fee of €20, which will be refunded should the objection be valid.

Videoing of competitions is strictly forbidden.

The adjudicators decision is final.

The feis committee will not accept responsibility for personal injuries or articles lost a feis.

There is absolutely no smoking permitted anywhere in the building.

The committee as far as is practical, will provide a stage surface suitable for dancing.

However, the committee cannot accept any liability whatsoever for injuries sustained while on stage. The lodgement of any entry will be deemed to be acceptance of the provision by a dancer & by his/her parent/ guardian.

No make-up to be worn by children under 10.

Bun, Tus, Mean & Ard Grad competitions are open to all regions.

Cars are parked at owners risk.

Age to be taken from 1st January 2016.

Committee members may only approach the adjudicators.

THE USE OF FAKE TAN, MAKE-UP, WIGS & SOLO COSTUMES ARE STRICTLY FORBIDDEN IN BUN & TUS GRAD COMPETITION. THIS IS A CONNACHT RULING & WE WOULD APPRECIATE ANYONE TRAVELLING FROM OTHER REGIONS TO ABIDE BY THIS RULE.

Bun and Tusgrad competitions are confined to competitors who have never won 1st place for the dance specified in any registered competition in any other grade or under any age limit.

Meangrad competitions are confined to competitors who have never previously won 1st place in Mean or Ardgrad in any other registered competitions for the dance specified for that competition or in any solo competition designated a 'Championship' or 'Priomhcomortas' under the maximum age limit specified for that Meangrad or under a higher age limit.

<u>Preliminary</u> is confined to competitors who have not been placed in the top five in an Open Championship judged by three or more Adjudicators. The winner of a Preliminary Championship automatically eliminates the dancer from dancing in grades lower than prelim. The dancer must not have qualified for the World Championships 2015 or 2016, (with the exception of boys who are eligible if they qualified but did not place in the top 3 at their Oireachtas and otherwise fulfil the requirements of Prelim, or have been regraded). The dancer must not have won a Preliminary Championship three or more times with effect from 1st January 2015.
