	Dancer's age is determined as of January 1 st .
	Competitors must be in the hall, prepared to dance, one hour prior to the scheduled beginning of their event.
	Dancers who appear in competitions in which they are not entered and paid will not be eligible for placement or awards.
	First feis competitions are open only to dancers who have never competed at a feis.
	The feis committee reserves the right to combine or split competitions following the guidelines of the NAFC and the Western US Region Teacher's Association. All efforts will be made to combine competitions where there are fewer than 5 competitors entered.

Level Advancement	If a dancer moves up level(s), there will be no fee if changed by 6:00 p.m. or within two hours of the conclusion of Grade competitions on Saturday. Otherwise, changes made on Sunday will be subject to a \$10 fee change. If advancement is from Grades to Preliminary Champ, the \$15 difference in entry fees will be due regardless. NOTE: If you are a Preliminary Champ and receive your 3 rd first place win on Saturday, you must move to Open Championship to compete on Sunday at the Scottsdale Feis.
