COVID CONSIDERATIONS

Feis attendees and participants – dancers, families, and Feis staff – must comply with all government and hotel pandemic policies and rules in effect at the time of the Feis. As of this writing in December that means masks are required. <u>All participants</u> age 12 and over will be required to provide proof of COVID-19 vaccination. In lieu of vaccination verification, a negative COVID-19 test result taken within 72 hours prior to the event may be presented.

The Feis Committee may make adjustments and changes to the conduct of the Feis to accommodate pandemic policies and rules. This may include limiting the number of dancers on stage and limiting the number of attendees in the ballroom. We hope to avoid any such action.

Hotel check-in will not require vaccination proof or negative covid test, but it will be necessary at the restaurant.

We hope that official pandemic regulations in March are not as restrictive. We will try to keep all entrants informed if there are changes. And we will appreciate your cooperation.

DANCING COMPETITION RULES

- 1. Competitions may be combined if warranted by the number of entries.
- 2. Competitors must be in the hall, prepared to dance, one hour prior to the scheduled beginning of their event.
- 3. Dancers who appear in competitions in which they are not entered and paid will not be eligible for placement or awards.
- 4. First Feis competitions are open only to dancers who have never competed at a feis.
- 5. When awards are announced from the stage, competitors must be in costume, including dance shoes, to receive their awards.
- 6. The Comerford School of Irish Dance, Celtic Arts Northwest, the Doubletree by Hilton Seattle Airport, the Feis Committee and anyone associated with the Committee in putting on the Feis, shall not be held responsible or liable for any personal injury, property loss, or damage incurred before, during, or after the feis, by any participants, or by anyone attending the event.

ENTRY PROCEDURES AND FEES

Entries are handled by FeisWorx – www.feisworx.com. Payments should be made online. Payments by mail must be payable IN US DOLLARS **to Comerford School**, and mailed to Comerford Schooll c/o FeisWorx, PO Box 2046, Parker, CO 80134. Online payment is strongly recommended to avoid problems with mail delivery. Mail from Canada is especially slow – two week lead time is recommended.

Entries and payments are due February 18th 2022. Payments postmarked after that date must include a \$30 late fee.

NOTE: Entry fees are non-refundable.

SODA BREAD COMPETITION

Three <u>classes</u> of competition: <u>white, brown and currant</u>. Entries will be done at the Feis. Entries must be labeled with the class of bread and the entrant's name and school. Entries must be submitted at the Feis entrance table by <u>10:30 AM on Saturday</u>. Criteria for judging will be appearance, texture and taste. Results will be announced Saturday afternoon. Entries will not be returned. No advance registration or fee for entries.

ART COMPETITION

Open to all ages – family members as well as dancers. Must be original artwork, using any media, done by entrant, depicting Celtic theme or subject. Entrees will be divided by age based upon entries. Must be delivered by <u>noon on Saturday</u>, and labeled with entrant's name, age (adults may simply identify as "adult") and school. No advance registration or entry fee.
