DAY SCHEDULE

Dancing will begin at 8:00am on Saturday AND Sunday. A full schedule will be posted on www.feiworx.com and social media sites approximately one week prior to the event. Schedule is subject to change based on registrations. Day schedule is as follows and not necessarily in this order.

- All First Feis and Grades Solo Competitions including Adults and Specials (Treble Reel and Slip Jigs)
- All Reel Trophy (Beg/Adv. Beg) and Treble Jig Trophy (Nov/Prizewinner) competitions.
- All Preliminary and Open Championships.
- All Championship Specials Treble Reel and Slip Jig Special competitions.

Sunday June 5th 2022

- All teams
- All Reel Trophy (Beg /Adv. Beg) and Treble Jig Trophy (Nov/Prizewinner) competitions.
- All Preliminary and Open Championships.
- The all new TIM O'HARE MEMORIAL BOYS REEL TROPHY -open to all Prelim/Open Champ level boys.
- *ALBERTA BELT CHAMPION OF CHAMPIONS DANCE OFF. Dancers must dance in the full championship competitions on both Saturday AND Sunday to be eligible for the Alberta Belt Dance Off. FIRST PLACE DANCERS ONLY will be able to compete in the Champion of Champions Dance off. Dress code: All Black.

^{*} The Alberta Belt Dance Off will consist of a Prelim and Open Category. The category will be split into Junior and Senior belts should the number of participants permit.

^{*}Both days of Championship competitions will be danced in full costume.

^{*}Grade dancers may enter both trophy competitions. Dancers who win on the Saturday: if it is your second trophy win (moving you to Preliminary Championships at your next feis) then you will forfeit your entry into Sunday's Novice/Prizewinner Trophy Competition (with no fee refund).

^{*}Different judges will be coordinated over the weekend, so you are not judged by the same judge in any Championships or Trophy Dances.

REGISTRATION AND PAYMENT

Entries will be processed through www.feisworx.com Deadline for entries Saturday, May 14th, 2022. Entries made after this point will be subject to a \$30.00 late fee. Payment must be received prior to the feis, or late fees will apply.

Your entry on Feisworx is your commitment to pay. If you decide not to attend the feis, please withdraw your entry **PRIOR** to the closing date. No substitutions, or changes accepted after the closing date, with the exception of updates to dancer status.

A family admission fee of \$45.00 will be added to all entries.

FEIS RULES

- 1. Competitions are open to amateurs only. Only students of teachers registered in good standing with the WCIDTA, IDTANA, and An Coimisiun Le Rinci Gaelacha may compete.
- 2. Competitors ages will be determined as of January 1st, 2022.
- 3. Entry forms are to be checked and signed by the registered teacher.

4. Entry fees:

Family Maximum \$160.00 – Family Maximum pertains to two or more dancers in one family. Excluded in Family Maximum: Admission, Specials and Art Competitions

Solo Competitions \$7.00 per dance/per competitor
Figure Dancing \$5.00 per competitor/per team
Choreography \$2.00 per competitor/per team
BEG/ADV. BEG. Trophy Competitions \$20.00 per

BEG/ADV. BEG. Trophy Competitions \$20.00 per competitor NOV/ PRZ. Trophy Competitions \$20.00 per competitor.

Prelim/Open Championship \$50.00 per competitor.
Treble Reel Special \$15.00 per competitor
Slip Jig Special \$15.00 per competitor
TIM O'HARE Boys Reel Special \$10.00 per competitor

<u>First Feis</u> – A dancer who has never previously competed in a registered feis.

<u>Beginner</u> – A dancer who has not qualified for Advanced Beginner in that particular dance.

<u>Advanced Beginner</u> – A dancer who has received qualifying place in that particular dance in the Beginner level but has not yet qualified to move on to Novice.

Novice - A dancer who has received a qualifying place in that particular dance in the Advanced Beginner level, but has not yet qualified to move on to Prizewinner for that particular dance.

<u>Prizewinner</u> - A dancer who has received a qualifying place in that particular dance in the Novice level, but has not yet qualified to advance to Preliminary Championships.

<u>Beginner/Advanced Beginner Trophy</u> - (Reel 32 bars) Open to dancers who dance the majority of their dances in the Beginner or Advanced Beginner level in solos. A dancer must advance to Novice/Prizewinner Trophy if they receive two first place Trophies in this level, or if they advance in their solo levels.

<u>Novice/Prizewinner Trophy</u> - (Treble Jig, 32 bars, choice of 2 speeds) Open to dancers who dance the majority of their dances in the Novice or Prizewinner levels in solos. Also, open to dancers who have previously won two first place trophies in the Beginner/Advanced Beginner Trophy Competitions. Dancers in ALL age groups will dance the Treble Jig.

<u>Preliminary Championships</u> - Open to dancers who have won two first place trophies in the Novice/Prizewinner Trophy Competition, and who have not previously won two first place Preliminary Championships.

Open Championships – Open to dancers who have previously won two first place Preliminary Championships.

- 5. Dancers may only dance each dance once, the exception being dancers who are entered in First Feis competitions, who may also dance in Beginner for those dances.
- 6. In Figure dancing, 50% of a team may be moved to a higher age group to complete a figure unless the Feis Committee has granted special permission. All Ceili dances must be performed in accordance with the Official book "An Rince Foirne"
- 7. A competition may be cancelled or combined with a higher age group if there are less than 3 entries. If there is a large entry, (as per WCIDTA Rules) the competition may be split at the feis committee's discretion.
- 8. Dancers should be in the hall 60 minutes before scheduled time of their competition.
- 9. All dancers must be in costume, complete with shoes and number to receive any award onstage.
- 10. Under no circumstances are the adjudicators or the musicians to be approached during the feis. The decision of the adjudicator is final.
- 11. No steel taps or bubble heels allowed. Shoes may be subject to inspection by adjudicators. Costumes must be in accordance with the IDTANA and An Coimisiun guidelines.
- 12. The Western Canadian Open Alberta Belt, The named Chairpersons, W.C.I.D.T.A., The Hyatt Regency Hotel, The City of Calgary, or any organization affiliated with same will not be held responsible for personal injury, property loss or damage during an event.
- 13. Protest against a breach of rules will be considered if made in writing and signed by the objector. The objection must also, be accompanied with a \$25.00 fee and reach the feis committee before prizes are presented. If the complaint is justified, the \$25.00 fee will be refunded.
- 14. Competitors may only compete in a Trophy competition **OR** a Championship, but not both. Treble Reel Trophies and Specials do not apply in this case.
- 15. Any form of unauthorized photography which has the capability to capture a dancer's image whilst in motion, using electronic or manual means ie: mobile phone, standard camera, video camcorder, commercial film, with or without enhancement, is expressly forbidden in competition. Photography is permitted on a limited basis during First Feis and Beginner Categories ONLY. No Video equipment will be allowed in the hall. Photography during awards is permitted.
- 16. Notwithstanding any other condition specified herein, The Feis Committee reserves the right to refuse any entry and alter or cancel any rule or condition as it may be deemed necessary in the best interest of the feis. The decision of the feis committee is final.
- 17. Dancers shall advance in each individual solo dance as follows: Number of dancers **who danced** in a Competition Placing(s) that move dancer(s) to the next level.

| Number of dancers who danced in a Competition | Placing(s) that move dancers to the next level |
|---|--|
| < 5 | No placing advances |
| 5 – 9 | 1st place moves up |
| 10 - 19 | 1 st , 2 nd , and 3 rd , moves up |
| 19 – 29 | 1 st , 2 nd , 3 rd , 4 th , moves up |
| 30 or more | 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th, and 5th, move up |

- 18. Dancers shall advance in trophy competitions and Championships as follows:
 - A dancer who wins two first place trophies in the Beginner/Advanced Beginner Trophy advances to the Novice/Prizewinner Trophy, or:
 - A dancer who advances to Novice or Prizewinner for the majority of their solo levels (hard shoes in particular) automatically advances to the Novice/prizewinner Trophy.
 - A dancer who wins two first places Novice/Prizewinner Trophy competitions advances to Preliminary Championships.
 - A dancer who wins two first place Preliminary Championship competitions advances to Open Championships
 - Should a dancer win a second Preliminary Championship on the first day of competition, they are eligible to move to Open Championship on the second day of competition. If they choose to withdraw from a pre-registered second' Preliminary Championship, they are not eligible for a refund from that competition, but may transfer that registration fee to the Open Championship competition.
- 19. All other Feis rules as per An Coimisiun Le Rinci Gaelacha, the I.D.T.A.N.A. and the W.C.I.D.T.A.
