FROM NORTH NJ: Take Garden State Parkway south to exit 91 (Lakewood/Brick Twp). Take ramp to Pt Pleasant/Herbertsville/Burnt Tavern Rd East. Turn slight right on to Lanes Mill Road, turn right on Burnt Tavern Road (CR 549), bear right to go on Burnsville Road which becomes Lanes Mill Road. Continue ½ mile to school.

FROM PHILA AREA: Take NJ Turnpike north to exit 7A. Merge on to CR 547. Turn left on Herbertsville Rd (CR 549). Go 3 ½ miles and turn right on Sally Ike Road. Go 1 ½ miles and turn left at Lanes Mill Road.

FROM SOUTH NJ: Take Garden State Parkway north to exit 90 (Brick). Turn slight right and then left on to Chambers Bridge Rd. Follow Chambers Bridge Road for 2 miles and turn right on to Burnt Tavern Road to Burnsville Road which becomes Lanes Mill Road. Continue ½ mile to school.
