^{*} The approval of this syllabus is simply to ensure that the dancers, numbers of competitions etc.. listed therein, adhere to the rules and regulations of Comhairle Chonnachta and An Coimisiun le Rince Gaelacha. It is important to highlight that during the Covid 19 pandemic, it is solely the responsibility of the organisers to ensure that all feiseanna abide by the relevant advice and directives of the government, HSE and public health authorities in force at the time of the event.



Rialacha na Féile:

- Entries will only be accepted from teachers currently registered with An Coimisiún le Rincí Gaelacha.
- 2. Age will be reckoned from the 1st of January 2022.
- 3. The use of camcorders is not permitted during dancing.
- 4. Objections must be lodged within one hour of the announcement of a competition result and accompanied by a fee of €15 from registered teachers only.
- The feis committee will not accept any responsibility for personal injuries or damage to property on premises.
- 6. Competitors in Bungrád and Túsgrád may only wear a class costume, dress or skirt top.
- 7. Make-up, wigs and fake tan is not permissible.

Taillí:

8. Bungrád competitions are confined to those who have never won a first prize for that particular dance in any age group. Only basic steps may be performed. Tusgrád competitions are confined to dancers who have not won first prize in that particular dance in Tus, Mean or Árd Grád. Meangrád competitions are confined to dancers who have not won first prize in the particular dance in Mean or Árd.

- 9. No block, en pointe work, stationary or moving is allowed to be performed for all ages up to and including u/12.
- 10. PRELIM RULES RULES AND ELIGIBILITY To be eligible to compete in a Preliminary Championship:
- Dancers must not have placed in the top 3 in an Open Championship judged by 3 or more adjudicators.
- Dancers must not have won a Preliminary
 Championship more than 2 times in the current year,
 HOWEVER, if there are 5 are less in a Preliminary
 competition the dancer is still eligible to compete in
 Preliminary Championship.
- Dancers must not have qualified for Oireachtas Rince na Cruinne in the current year (2022) or previous year (2021).
- Dancers must not have recalled in the actual Championship at Oireachtas Rince na hEireann in the current year (2022) or previous year (2021).
- Dancers having won 2 Preliminary Championships may not compete in any Mean grad competition for the remainder of the year HOWEVER, if a dancer has won only one Preliminary Championship they may continue to compete in Mean grad (with the exception of the dances that they won the Prelim Championship with).
