It is with great pleasure that Tracey Taaffe Academy of Dance presents the 6th All County Irish Dance Championships/Grades, & Gold Cup Dance Off at our NEW VENUE for 2022, The Virginia Show Centre. Ideally located and very accessible to all, only 40 minutes from Dublin on the M3 and 1hr via Express Direct Bus from Dublin Airport. We are very excited to bring our championships for the very first time to the beautiful County of Cavan, surrounded by the lakes of Lough Ramor, Eircode A82A9X2. The Lakeside Manor Hotel just a five-minute drive away. Check them out online for their best rate.

We are hosting a two-day event this year with GRADES on Saturday June 11th starting at 9am. Open Championships 16-17, 17-18 18-20 Over 20 and Over 16 Preliminary Mixed Championships as well our Senior Gold Cup Dance Off will also take place on Saturday from 5pm.

Championships from Under 7 to Under16 as well as separate preliminary championships will take place on Sunday June12th as well as our Minor and Junior Gold Cup Dance Off.

Preliminary Championships will be a choice Reel or Slip Jig and Heavy Jig or Hornpipe and will be judged by a panel of 3 Adjudicators.

There will be a100% recall in all Open Championships. Exquisite prizes throughout the weekend. Craobh Comortas, 1st-5th cup, sash and a beautiful, customized medal on a ribbon to the top 20 dancers placed. Prelim 1st-5th cup, sash and a beautiful, customized medal on a ribbon for top 10 dancers placed. Medal on ribbon to all other placed dancers. Trad Set competitions trophy for1st and medals thereafter. Solo Dances Ard cup for 1st placed dancer and medals thereafter. Our Gold Cup Winners will be the proud owners of our Amazing Gold Cup to Keep with winner's name added to the Gold Cup Champions Archive.

All placed dancers in the Priomh Comortas will receive an All-County medal on a ribbon. In Graded competitions All dancers entered will place in the Reel and Priomh Comortas competitions.

Two Hand Competitions 1st place team will receive a cup each and medals thereafter.

Competitors in Bun Grad & Tus Grad, up to and including the Under 12 age group, may only wear traditional class costumes or long/short-sleeved blouses/shirts & skirts/trousers, polo tops & skirts/ trousers, body suits & skirts or tunics that conform to the regular costume length rule. Low-cut tops and short tight skirts are not permitted.

Make-up (including false eyelashes and tanner on the face) is not permitted for dancers, in either solo or team competitions, up to and including the Under 10 age group. Clarification: Both make up rules refer to the age group of the competition, not the actual age of the dancer. For example, 9-year-old dancers, competing in a team that is entered Under 12, may wear make-up or at a feis where the youngest Open Championship age group is Under 11, then all dancers in that competition may wear make up. These rules must also be announced from side stage at the event. Participants should be reminded that should they be in breach of these rules and be required to remove their make-up, that they risk missing their rotation in the competition. Costume Length: Length or costumes must adhere to principles or modesty and enable dancers to safely execute their movements and steps. Adjudicators who determine a costume to be too short or to lack modesty may ask a competitor to change into black tights (of a denier not less than 70 per cent) for the dancer to continue in the competition. When wearing body suits with skirts (commonly known as black-out attire) black tights (of a denier less than 70) must be worn from the age of 14 and above. As a point of clarification, this rule is not limited to just body suits but also to tops/ blouses and skirts/shorts of all colours and is in effect from the 14-15 age group upwards.

- To comply with health and safety measures, all dancers lining up, side stage prior to any round at any competition will be required to perform the simple exercise of raising their arms to shoulder level unhindered. If unable to do this by the time of their rotation due to costume stitching or arm attachments, these competitors will not be permitted to perform.
- Bun Grád competitions are confined to competitors who at the time of entry have never won 1st place (or being re graded as per below) in that particular dance in any age group or grade. Basic Steps only are permitted in Bun Grad.
 - Tus Grad confined to dancers who have never won 1st prize (or being graded as per below) for that particular dance in any age in Tus Grad, Mean Grad or Ard Grad. Dancers may perform either basic steps or their first hard/difficult version of each dance. Steps in Tus Grad Heavy Jigs and Hornpipe must be similar to those used in St.Patrick's Day and Blackbird.
 - Mean Grád competitions are confined to dancers who at the time of entry have never won 1st place for that particular dance in Mean Grad or Ard Grád in that age group or a higher age group.
- Preliminary Championship will be adjudicated by 3 Adjudicators and will consist of 2 Rounds, 1 Light Round Reel/Slip Jig and 1 Heavy Round Heavy Jig/Hornpipe. Dancers may compete in an Open or Preliminary Championship or Both.
 - **RULES AND ELIGIBILITY** To be eligible to compete in a Prelim Championship: Dancers must not have placed in the top 3 in an Open Championship judged by 3 or more adjudicators. Dancers must not have won a Preliminary Championship more than 2 times in the current year.

However, if there are 5 are less in a prelim competition the dancer is still eligible to compete in Preliminary Championship. Dancers must not have qualified for Oireachtas Rince na Cruinne in the current year or previous year. Dancers must not have recalled in the actual Championship at Oireachtas Rince na hEireann in the current year or previous year. Dancers having won 2 Preliminary Championships may not compete in any Mean grad competition for the remainder of the year however, if a dancer has won only one Preliminary Championship they may continue to compete in Mean grad (with the exception of the dances that they have won the Prelim Championship with). Dancers who qualify for Oireachtas Rince na Cruinne where there are five dancers or less in the competition at their Regional Oireachtas are exempt from this ruling. They may remain in the Preliminary Championships if they so wish. Boys who have qualified for Oireachtas Rince na Cruinne but were not placed in the top 3 at their Regional Oireachtas and who otherwise fulfil the Prelim Criteria, may continue to compete in Preliminary Grade. Dancers will perform to the following speeds

 Bun Grad: Reel 122-124, Light Jig 116, Single Jig 124, Slip Jig 124, Heavy Jig 96, Hornpipe 144 Tus Grad: Reel 116-118, Light Jig 116, Single Jig 124, Slip Jig 120, Heavy Jig 82, Hornpipe 130 Mean/Ard Grad: Reel 113, Light Jig 116, Single Jig 124, Slip Jig 113, Heavy Jig 73, Hornpipe 113 Traditional Set Dances: St. Patrick's Day 94, The Blackbird 144, Job of Journeywork 138, Garden of Daisies 138, King of the Fairies 130, Three Sea Captains 96, Jockey to the Fair 90
- All competitors will be required a dance a minimum number of 40 bars, except in Slip Jigs, Hornpipes & Bun Grad Reels where a minimum number of 32 bars will be required.
- 1-20 Competitors 1st Place regraded 21-40 Competitors 1st & 2nd places regraded 41and over Competitors 1st, 2nd & 3rd places regraded
- Any form of unauthorised photography which has the capability to capture a dancer's image whilst in motion, using electronic or manual means e.g., mobile phones, iPad, standard cameras, video camcorders, cine recorder, commercial film, with or without flash enhancement, is forbidden during competition.
- Changing of costumes, dressing, and undressing, is not permitted in the halls or public areas.
- No block, en point, stationery or moving will be allowed for all ages up to and including Under 12. However, dancers who will be competing in the 12-13 age group in the following year, will be exempt from this rule from 1st September.
 - If you wish your child to be excluded from any photographs that maybe uploaded onto social media websites, please ensure that you inform the feis organiser in advance.
 - The adjudicators decision is final. Any objections must be lodged in writing within one hour of result, accompanied by fee of
- The feis committee will not accept any responsibility for personal injuries or articles lost at the feis. The feis committee reserves the right to transfer competitions/results to a different stage or to alternate competitions if it becomes necessary in order to help the feis run smoothly.
 - Appropriate undergarments covering the midriff must be worn. Undergarments must provide full coverage (as per illustration on www.clrg.ie). Dancers wearing undergarments that do not cover the areas of the body as in the illustrated example will be asked to put on black tights of a denier of not less than 70%. This is monitored by the adjudicator. For competitions adjudicated by a panel of more than one adjudicator all adjudicator on the panel must agree to ask the dancer to put on tights.




