- Winner sash and trophy for each solo dance in Bun, Tus & Mean.
- Grade Priomh Comortais: Top 5 trophy & sashes, all participants Medallion medal.
- Prelim: Top 5 trophy & sashes, all participants Medallion medal.
- Craobh Comortais: Top 5 trophy & sashes, all participants Medallion medal. solos winner - trophy.

Fees:

Grade solos: **€5 per dance**

Family Fees:

€60 for Grade entries (Not including Grade Priomh Comortais)

€100 combination grade entries including Grade Priomh Comortais

€120 for combination grade entries including Grade Priomh Comortais and Craobh Comortais.

Family Fees are applicable to siblings' entries, not individual dancers entering multiple grades.

Dances:

Under 5 & 5-6 (Reel and Light Jig)

6 - 7 (Reel, Single Jig and Light Jig)

7 -8 & 8-9 Reel, Heavy Jig and Traditional Set

All other Age Groups (Reel or Slip Jig), (Heavy Jig or Hornpipe), Open Set Dance.

100% recall, dancers will compete 2 at a time and perform 32 bars Slip Jig and Hornpipe and 40bars Reel and Heavy Jig. The feis committee reserves the right to employ relief adjudicators and operate a recall and a separate non recall set competition if entry numbers are high to prevent the feis running considerably overtime.

Rules / Rialacha:

- 1. Feis registered with An Comisiun le Rinci Gaelacha.
- 2. Age reckoned from January 1st 2022.
- 3. Entries accepted from registered teachers only.
- 4. Persons may not approach adjudicators.
- 5. Objections, in writing accompanied by a fee of €20 must be lodged within 10 minutes of the results.
- 6. Feis committee will not be responsible for articles lost or stolen.
- 7. Strictly no camcorders or photography is permitted during competitions.
- 8. No block, en point work, stationary or moving is allowed in age groups up to and including under 12.
- 9. It is a rule of An Comhairle Chonnachta that all Bunghrad and Tusghrad competitors, regardless of their region of residence, wear a class costume or a simple skirt / top or dress. It is not permissible to wear fake tan, make up or wigs in these grades.
- 10. Where there are less than 5 competitors in any competition the winner will not be moved to the next grade.
- 11. The committee as far as is practical will provide a stage surface suitable for dancing. However the committee cannot accept any liability whatsoever for injuries sustained while on stage or back stage. The lodgement of an entry will be deemed to be an acceptance of the provision by a dancer and by his / her parent / guardian.

• Bunghrad:

Confined to competitors who have never won 1st prize in dance specified in any age group in a registered competition.

Basic steps only.

• Tusghrad:

Confined to competitors who have never won 1st prize in dance specified in Tusghrad, Meanghrad or Ardghrad in any group in a registered competition.

Meanghrad:

Competitors who have never won 1st prize in Meanghrad ,or Ardghrad for dance specified in any age group in a registered competition.

• Preliminary: <u>RULES AND ELIGIBILITY</u>

To be eligible to compete in a Preliminary Championship:

- Dancers must not have placed in the top 3 in an Open Championship judged by 3 or more adjudicators.
- Dancers must not have won a Preliminary Championship more than 2 times in the current year, **HOWEVER**, if there are 5 are less in a Preliminary competition the dancer is still eligible to compete in Preliminary Championship.
- Dancers must not have qualified for Oireachtas Rince na Cruinne in the current year (2022) or previous year (2021).
- Dancers must not have recalled in the actual Championship at Oireachtas Rince na hEireann in the current year (2022) or previous year (2021).
- Dancers having won 2 Preliminary Championships may not compete in any Mean grad competition for the remainder of the year **HOWEVER**, if a dancer has won only one Preliminary Championship they may continue to compete in Mean grad (with the exception of the dances that they won the Prelim Championship with).

^{**}The approval of this syllabus is simply to ensure that the dances, number of competitions etc.. listed therein, adhere to the rules and regulations of Comhairle Chonnachta and An Coimisiun le Rince Gaelacha. It is important to highlight that, during the Covid 19 pandemic, it is solely the responsibility of the organizers to ensure that all feiseanna abide by the relevant advice and directives of the government, HSE and public health authorities in force at the time of the event.
