- Beg & Adv. Beg. Light Jig: Each dancer performs the right and left foot of the light jig step, down the line, one at a time
- Beg & Adv. Beg. St Patrick's Day: Each dancer performs the traditional St. Patrick's Day set dance, two at a time
- Novice & PW Pre Champ Special: Each dancer will perform 1 step (right and left) of their soft shoe reel, and 1 step (right and left) of their treble jig, one dancer at a time
- Novice, PW, & Champ Choreography Treble Reels: Each dancer will perform 16 bars of a treble reel. A right and left foot are NOT required. Arm choreography is encouraged!!

- Each dancer on a Beg 4-Hand Mix Up team must be entered in at least one beginner solo competition at the feis
- Each team entered will sign up for the 4 hand reel (FIRST FIGURE WILL BE DANCED)
- REGISTRATION MUST BE COMPETED WITH FULL TEAMS FROM EACH SCHOOL
- Once at the feis, you will compete in the 4-hand reel in your own position, but with dancers from other schools. Teammates will be chosen at random, according to your practiced position, when lining up for this dance. You'll compete in teams with dancers from other schools
- Deirdre Abeid was a huge advocate of camaraderie between dancers in different schools, and she also liked a good joke. She would have loved to watch this special unfold!!

Entry Fees Per Feis

Please note that entry fees are NON-REFUNDABLE.

Competition Rules

- 1. Rules adopted by the Western US Region of IDTANA, member CLRG, are included by reference.
- 2. Rules and requirements for each competition as noted in the syllabus are included by reference.
- 3. Competitors must be in the hall prepared to dance one hour prior to the scheduled start of their event.
- 4. Competitions with fewer than five entrants may be combined or canceled by the Feis Committee; the Feis Committee may add or combine competitions at its discretion.
- 5. Competitors must be in costume, including soft shoes, to receive awards presented from stage.
- 6. All local health restrictions in place at the time of competition will be strictly adhered to.
- 7. In the event that the competition is canceled by the Committee due to local health restrictions, dancers will be refunded the value of their entry less a \$10 processing fee.
- 8. Haran School of Irish Dance, Feis at the Falls LLC, and anyone associated in producing the feis, including feis volunteers, shall not be held responsible or liable for any personal injury, property loss, or damage.
- 9. Entry constitutes acceptance of the rules and restrictions outlined herein.

Blackout Costume Rules

- 1. Costume for all dancers, Beginners through Champions, is modest black attire; NO dance costumes are permitted.
- 2. Suggested attire for girls/ladies is a skirt or skort with tights or socks; boys/gents may wear long pants.
- 3. Either long or short-sleeve shirts are acceptable; boys/gents should not wear ties, vests or jackets.
- 4. Girls/ladies hair should be pulled back neatly from the face; no wigs, crowns, tiaras or hairpieces. Light or no make-up is encouraged, with stud earrings only.
- 5. All costuming must conform to the costume requirements set forth by CLRG.
- 6. Branded attire (i.e. Nike, Adidas, etc.) should be small and discreet; NO school branded attire is permitted on stage.
- 7. No "bling" is permitted on any part of the costume (i.e. skirts, pants, tops, buckles, etc.).

Western U.S. Region Level Definitions and Advancement

- 1. First Feis is not per dance, but the first feis ever for the dancer. Only on first feis regardless of how many dances they are doing. Dancers may only enter First Feis once, even in case of back-to-back feiseanna.
- 2. In Beginner, Advanced Beginner, and Novice the following will apply:
 - a. 5-9 dancers; 1st place will advance to the next grade.
 - b. 10 or more dancers: 1st and 2nd places will advance to the next grade.
 - c. Dancers may not stay in level at Teacher discretion.
- 3. Prizewinner: advancement from Prizewinner to Preliminary Championship is at teacher discretion.
- 4. Preliminary to Open Championship: Must have 3 overall wins with 5 or more dancers, not at teacher discretion. Upon winning their 3rd overall win in Preliminary Championships, a dancer must move immediately to Open, even in the case of back-to-back feiseanna.
- 5. Adults: dancers who started after the age of 18 or have not competed for 5 years.
- 6. Dancers residing outside the Western U.S. Region should consult the rules for advancement within the region in which they reside.
