RIALACHA / RULES 1 Adjudicators' decision is final 2 Age as at 1st January 2022 3 Competitions are open to dancers from all regions.

4 Competitors in Bun Grad & Tus Grad, up to and including the Under 12 age group, may only wear traditional class costumes or long/short-sleewed blobuses/shirs & skirts/trousers, polo tops & skirts/trousers, body suits & skirts or tunics that conform to the regular costume length rule. Low-cut tops

and short tight skirts are not permitted.

Make-up (including false eyelashes and face-tan) is not be permitted for dancers, in either solo or team competitions, up

to and including the Under 10 age group.

Bun Grád competitions are confined to competitors who at the time of entry have never won 1st place (or being regraded

as per below) in that particular dance in any age group or grade. Basic Steps only are permitted in Bun Grad. T lus Grad confined to dancers who have never won 1st prize (or being graded as per below) for that particular dance in any age in Tus Grad, Mean Grad or Ard Grad. Dancers may perform either basic steps or their first hard/difficult version of each dance. Steps in Tus Grad Heavy Jigs and Hompipe must be

sensing to those used in St.Partick's Day and Blackbird.

Boncers may only perform a dance in Mean Grad, if they have never won 1st prize for that dance in Mean or Ard Grad in that age or a higher age.

9 Dances permitted in Rince Éadrom are : Reel, Light Jig, Single Jig or Slip Jig,
10 Dances permitted in Rince Trom are : Heavy Jig or Hornpipe

11 Dancers must perform to the following speeds

12 No block, en pointe work, stationery or moving is allowed to be performed for ages up to and including U11

13 The fels committee reserves the right to (a) transfer competitions/ results to a different hall and (b) alternate competitions, if it becomes necessary, in order to help the fels run more smoothly 14 Any form of unauthorised photography which has the capability to capture a dancer's image whilst in motion, using electronic or manual means e.g. mobile phone, standard camera, video camcorder, cine recorder, forbidden in

competition.commercial film, with or without flash enhancement, is expressly prohibited.
Re-grading of dancers: in Bun Grâd & Tus Grad competitions, one dancer moves up to next grade if there are less than 20 competitors, two dancers move up to next grade if there between 21 and 40 competitors and three up to next grade if there are over 40 competitors.

It Appropriate undergarments covering the midriff must be worn. Undergarments must provide full coverage (as per illustration on https://www.nctgr.iel/. Dancers wearing undergarments that do not cover the areas of the body as in the illustrate example will be asked to put on black tights of a denier of not less than 70%. This is monitored by the adjudicator for competitions adjudicated by a panel of more than one adjudicator all adjudicator on the panel must agree to ask the dancer to put on tights.

Preliminary Championship Rules - To be eligible to compete in a Prelim Championship:

- Dances must not have placed in the top 3 in an Opt Championship Judget by 3 or more adjudicates.
