FACE MASKS

All attendees *must wear a face mask at all times*. Please make sure the mask covers your MOUTH and NOSE. If you have a medical condition that precludes you from wearing a face mask, please do not attend our feis as you will not be permitted to enter. The feis will provide a mask for anyone that forgets one but we strongly encourage all to bring their own mask.

Dancers may remove their mask while dancing. Face masks must be worn at awards and while using the restrooms and at all other times. Please remember, wearing a face mask does not mean you don't have to social distance. All must remain 6 feet apart AND wear a mask.

1) Dancers must not have taken Irish Dancing lessons as a juvenile and must be at least 18 years of age on January 1, 2022.

2) Dancers may have taken Irish dance lessons as a juvenile but have not competed in any competition, solo or team, feiseanna or Oireachtaisi, except competitions specifically designated for adults within the past 5 years and must be at least 18 years of age as of January 1, 2022.
