## **ENTRY PROCEDURES & FEES**

Online entry only at [www.feisworx.com](http://www.feisworx.com) . Payment made online.

**Entry fees are non-refundable.**

**Entries and payments are due August 19, 2022.**

Entry fees must be received by the closing date to avoid late fees.

### **Entry fees:**

Soft shoe solos	\$25 (covers all soft shoe solos)
Hard shoe solos	\$20 (covers all hard shoe solos)
Specials/Trophy Competitions	\$10 (each)
Gladys Means Special	\$15
Preliminary Championships	\$45 (2 rounds)
Adult and Open Championships	\$60 (3 rounds)
Family registration fee	\$35 per family
Late entry fee	\$50 for entries after Aug 19, 2022
Art Competition	\$5 each

There is a \$175 maximum fee per family (including adult dancers), **excluding** late fees, specials/trophy competitions, and family entry fee.

## **LEVEL ADVANCEMENT & DEFINITION**

**First Feis** is not per dance. It is the first Feis ever for the dancer. Dancers may only enter First Feis once, even in case of back-to-back Feiseanna.

### **In B1, B2 and Novice the following will apply:**

5 - 9 dancers                      1st place will advance to the next grade  
10 or more dancers              1st and 2nd places will advance to the next grade  
\*Dancers may not stay in level at Teacher discretion.

**Prizewinner:** Advancement from Prizewinner to Preliminary Championship is at teacher discretion.

**Preliminary to Open Championship:** Must have 3 overall wins with 5 or more dancers, not at teacher discretion. Upon winning their 3rd overall win in Preliminary Championships, a dancer must move immediately to Open, even in the case of back-to-back Feiseanna.

**Adults:** Dancers who started after the age of 18 or have not competed for 5 years.

## **CHAMPIONSHIPS**

All championships will be adjudicated by a panel of three. Each round of the Championship (Reel/Slip Jig, Jig/Hornpipe, Set Dance) will be judged by one adjudicator to give a solo competition result. At the end of the championship, there will be an overall championship result in addition to results of individual solo rounds.

**NOTE: Under 9 Prelim and Open Championship competitors MUST do a traditional set for their set round.**

## **DANCING COMPETITION RULES**

1. Competitions will be combined or added as the Committee sees fit, based on the entries.
2. Competitors must be in the hall, prepared to dance, one hour prior to the scheduled beginning of their event.
3. Dancers who appear in competitions in which they are not entered and paid will not be eligible for placement or awards.
4. First Feis competitions are open only to dancers who have never competed at a feis.
5. When awards are announced from the stage, competitors must be in costume, including dance shoes, to receive their awards.
6. The Malone Academy of Irish Dance, or the Town and Country will not be held responsible or liable for personal injury, property loss and/or damage. By entering this Feis, the entrant and/or the entrant's parent or legal guardian agrees to indemnify and hold harmless the Hidden Valley Feis, The Feis Committee, Feis Volunteers, Vendors, Town and Country, the Donna Means School of Irish Dance, the Malone Academy of Irish Dance for any liabilities or personal injury as a result of the entrant's participation.

## **COVID-19 Disclaimer**

While we don't foresee any need for modifications to our event, the Hidden Valley Feis, amendments to this syllabus and attendee regulations may be required in order to ensure a safe event for all.

We have been working with Town And Country Resort to allow for options should we need to utilize outdoor space to maintain as full a feis as possible. However, we may need to amend the number of dancers on stage at one time, number of steps performed per dance, which dances will be required, or entry cap in order to provide a safe feis in line with current restrictions and protocols for San Diego County, CA as we near our feis date.
