

PLEASE NOTE: Competitors in First Feis, Beginner and Advanced Beginner competitions must wear either a school costume or blouse and shirt. There are NO solo/dress costumes allowed. Detailed schedule and printable competitor numbers will be available prior to the Feis at www.patriciamurphyschool.com. All competitors should be prepared to dance 3 at a time up to and including under 14, WITH THE EXCEPTION

OF GRADES LEVEL REELS, they will be 2 at a time.

FIRST FEIS: Competition #101. Open to dancers under 8 who have never competed in a Feis before today. 1 step reel (speed 122).

BEGINNER: A competitor who has not taken Irish Dance lessons from a registered teacher prior to 9/1/18.

Two steps, Boys & Girls combined for reel and jig. Dancer must move into Adv Beginner next year. Reel & Slip Jig Speed 122; Light Jig Speed 115.

Reel & Slip Jig Speed 122, Light Jig 115, Treble Jig 92, Hornpipe 138.

<u>PRELIMINARY</u>: Preliminary Championships in the Mid Atlantic Region: Preliminary Championships are open to competitors who have placed 1st in Prizewinner light (Reel or Slip Jig) and Treble (Jig or Hornpipe) dances. Boys and Girls combined. Preliminary dancers who win THREE first places in a calendar year must move to Open Championship the following calendar year. When a third 1st place win is achieved over several calendar years, the dancer must move to Open Championship the following weekend. All age groups under 14 will dance 3 at a time. Older age groups will dance 2 at a time.

 Hard Shoe will be danced first.
 PLEASE NOTE: Dancers <u>must choose</u> one of the following options to dance:

 <u>OPTION #1</u>: Reel & Hard Shoe Jig
 <u>OPTION #2</u>: Reel & Hornpipe

 <u>OPTION #3</u>: Slip Jig & Hard Shoe Jig
 <u>OPTION #4</u>: Slip Jig & Hornpipe


