Advanced Adults:

- -An Advanced Adult dancer is defined as anyone age 18 or older who as previously placed in the top 3 of a Prelim Championship or competed in Open Champ levels in the youth/&over levels regardless of when the competitor was active.
- -An Advanced Adult dancer has opted to leave the Youth/&Over categories and once the dancer begins competing in Advance Adult, the dancer may not return to Youth/&Over categories.
- -Advanced Adult Championships at NAIDC 2024 and WUSR 2024 will dance Reel/hornpipe. In 2025, Advanced Adults shall follow the rotation of dances for the Senior Ladies/Med age groups. For the recall round, set of choice will be performed.
- -All music for Adult competitions will be played at traditional speeds
