In 2025, Advanced Adults shall follow the rotation of dances for the Senior Ladies/Med age groups. For the recall round, set of choice will be performed. -All music for Adult competitions will be played at traditional speeds <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• 2 dancers at a time, 2 Steps, right and left (32 bars), traditional set</li> </ul>
