### \*Dancing Competition Rules\*

1. Rules adopted by the Western US Region of IDTANA, member CLRG, are included by reference.

2. Rules and requirements for each competition as noted in the syllabus are included by reference.

3. Competitors must be in the hall prepared to dance one hour prior to the scheduled start of their event.

4. The Feis Committee reserves the right to combine and split competitions at their discretion. Competitions with 26 or more entrants will be split, and efforts will be made to combine competitions with less than 5 entrants.

5. Dancers who appear in competitions in which they are not entered and paid will not be eligible for placement or awards.

6. When awards are announced at the awards area, competitors must be in costume, including dance shoes, to receive their awards.

7. All local health restrictions in place at the time of competition will be strictly adhered to.

8. The McKeever School of Irish Dance, E. Claire Raley Studios for the Performing Arts, George Sim Community Center, and anyone associated in producing the feis, including feis volunteers, will not be held responsible or liable for personal injury, property loss and/or damage. By entering this Feis, the entrant and/or the entrant's parent or legal guardian agrees to indemnify and hold harmless the The McKeever School Feis, The Feis Committee, Feis Volunteers, Vendors, E. Claire Raley Studios for the Performing Arts, George Sim Community Center, the McKeever School of Irish Dance for any liabilities or personal injury as a result of the entrant's participation.

### \*Western U.S. Region Level Definitions & Advancement\*

1. First Feis is not per dance, but the first feis ever for the dancer. Only one first feis regardless of how many dances they are doing. Dancers may only enter First Feis once, even in case of back-to-back feiseanna.

2. In Beginner, Advanced Beginner, and Novice the following will apply:

- a. 5 9 dancers: 1st place will advance to the next grade.
- b. 10 or more dancers: 1st and 2nd places will advance to the next grade.
- c. Dancers may not stay in level at Teacher discretion.

3. Prizewinner: Advancement from Prizewinner to Preliminary Championship is at teacher discretion.

4. Preliminary to Open Championship: Must have 3 overall wins with 5 or more dancers, not at teacher discretion. Upon winning their 3rd overall win in Preliminary Championships, a dancer must move immediately to Open, even in the case of back-to-back feiseanna (and 2nd Chance competitions).

5. Adults: Dancers who started after the age of 18 or have not competed for 5 years.

6. Dancers residing outside the Western U.S. Region should consult the rules for advancement within the region in which they reside.

• First Feis, Beginner 1 and 2, Novice, and Prizewinner competitions: 2 full steps (32 bars), and full Traditional Set.
