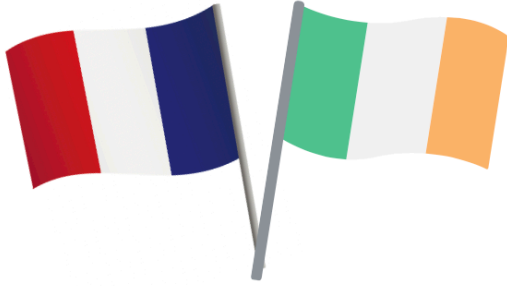

It was a delight to be asked to contribute this foreword to the programme for the European and Asian Qualifying Championships for the World Irish dance championships. As Ambassador of Ireland to France, I extend the warmest of welcomes to France to those of you who have travelled here for this event.

It is a testament to the extraordinary appeal of Irish dance that more than a thousand competitors from 23 countries are converging on the beautiful city of Aix-en-Provence for this event. Our unique dance tradition is one of our great national treasures, binding together not only the Irish diaspora worldwide, but also all those who are captivated by its inimitable grace and dynamism.

John Cullinane, the historian of Irish dance, conveyed its allure well in his accounts of 'the fastest footwork of all the dances in the world'. That allure is as great today as it has ever been, and it extends into new frontiers.

Ireland's Embassy in Paris last year had the great pleasure of welcoming the Irish dance group and TikTok sensation Cairde to our home on Avenue Foch. Cairde, who visited France with the support of my colleagues in Tourism Ireland, performed in iconic locations around Paris, including the Eiffel Tower and the Sacré Cœur. Their visit even took in a dance-off with the Can-Can dancers of the Moulin Rouge, a wonderful cultural encounter between Ireland and France. I know this tournament will be another.

I have the privilege to represent the Government of Ireland in France, and one of the great pleasures of my role is seeing how our culture takes root around the world.

In particular, I witness almost every day the enthusiasm of those who promote it: in the case of Irish dance, your twin passions for the percussive energy of our hard shoe dance and the poise and intricacy of those wearing the soft shoe.

I want to thank you for that passion. I also want to specifically thank the organisers of this qualifying tournament, not least Joanne Doyle, who has done so much to promote Irish dance worldwide.

To those participating, remember the wise words of the great choreographer, Martha Graham: "There is a vitality, a life force, an energy, a quickening, that is translated through you into action, and because there is only one of you in all time, this expression is unique."

LuAnn enjoys traveling to many Irish Dancing events as a teacher, adjudicator and makeup artist.

Kevin was born in Glasgow, Scotland and began playing music at age 6 as part of the local Comhaltas Ceoltóirí Éireann branch -

St Roch's Irish Minstrels CCE. He began playing the Tin Whistle and later the Piano Accordion, Piano. At age 12 Kevin won his first All Ireland title on the Piano Accordion at the Fleadh Cheoil na hÉireann in Clonmel Tipperary, 2004 - becoming the youngest person outside of Ireland to do so. Since then another 9 titles have followed including successes in both the Piano and Accompaniment competitions and most recently 3 Senior Piano Accordion titles in a row.

Kevin studied Law at the University of Strathclyde in Glasgow and since completing his degree in 2015 he has spent the following years, not in a legal firm, but touring with a number of Irish Dance shows including Spirit of Ireland, Rhythm of The Dance and Celtic Legends as well as playing at feiseanna around the world. In early 2017 Kevin teamed up with William Paterson and began work on the 'Beat Feis App' - the first downloadable app that was exclusively dedicated to the streaming of Irish dance

music. The app was launched in the December of 2018 after two years of work.

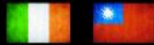

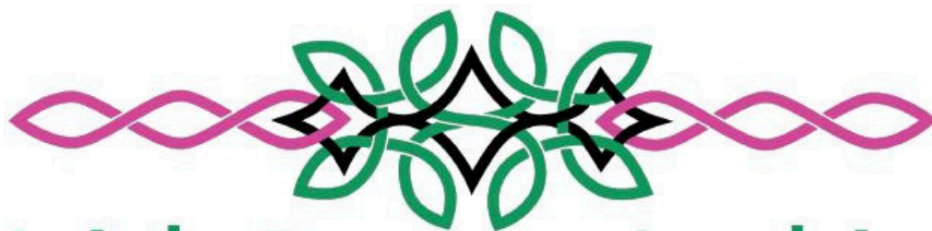
