## NOTES FOR GRADE LEVELS

1. The Committee plans to SPLIT grade events if number of entrants exceeds 30. We will also make every effort to appropriately COMBINE grade events (within the same competition level) for events with less than 5 entries except in adult competitions. Decisions will be made after entries have closed.
2. Dance speed is indicated in parenthesis next to each dance
3. Dancers entering a treble jig or hornpipe in the novice and prizewinner levels must specify a speed.
4. Dancers in Beginner and Advanced Beginner are not permitted to wear solo costumes
5. Dancers will perform 32 bars of each dance and will perform 2-at-a-time

1. PC/OC dancers must select HP/TJ and RL/SJ when registering
2. Dancers will perform 40 bars of dancing for HP and SJ and 48 bars of dancing for TJ and RL.
3. Dancers will perform 2-at-a-time for Rounds 1 & 2.
4. The feis committee may combine competitions with less than 5 entries. Decisions will be made after entries have closed.

#### NOTES FOR ADULT LEVEL COMPETITIONS

1. Adults cannot enter both the Adult Grades or Trad Set Competition (7299) AND the Adult Championship (8999) Or the Advanced Adult Championship (9999)
2. Adult champs will perform 40 bars of dancing for HP and SJ and 48 bars of dancing for TJ and RL.
3. Champ level adult dancers must specify reel/slip jig, treble jig/hornpipe and choice of Traditional Set when entering.
4. Dancers will perform 2-at-a-time for Rounds 1 & 2.
5. ADULT CHAMPIONSHIP: An Adult Champion is a dancer over the age of 18, who either began Irish Dance as an adult, or danced as a youth, but did not ever place in top 3 of a Prelim Championship. A dancer moves into the adult champion level by winning 1st place in reel, slip jig, treble jig, and hornpipe in Adult Prizewinner competitions or by their teacher's permission. When a dancer begins competing in the Adult Championship level, they may not compete in Adult Grades or youth/& over category. Upon winning two Adult Championships, the dancer may progress on to Advanced Adult Championships at their teacher's discretion.
6. ADVANCED ADULT CHAMPIONSHIP: An Advanced Adult dancer is defined as anyone age 18 or older who has previously placed in the top 3 of a Prelim Championship or competed in Open Champ levels in the youth/&over levels regardless of when the competitor was active. A dancer competing in Advanced Adult Championship may not compete in Adult Grades or the Adult Championship or in any youth/& over category.
