- Entry fees Before registering, please check your local school, work, and travel advisory rules. There will be
 absolutely <u>NO REFUNDS</u> even if you are not allowed to attend the Feis. The Feis committee has to pre-pay for
 much of the Feis weeks before the Feis and the funds will not be available for any refunds even for reasons
 due to the pandemic including illness, changes in quarantine requirements, or weather. If the Feis is
 cancelled for any reason, refunds will be issued to all competitors minus the gate fee and Feis web fee. We
 will not respond to any requests for refunds.
- This is a black out feis with the following suggestions:
- All dancers, Beginners through Champions, may wear modest black attire.
- Black tights are recommended for ladies/girls with a skirt or skort. Either long or short sleeves are
 acceptable. Tops must meet the costume requirements set forth by the CLRG (e.g., cover the collarbone).
- Suggested attire for gents is long pants and either long or short sleeved shirt. No collared shirt or tie is necessary.
- Branded logos (e.g., Nike, Adidas) should be small and discreet.
- Blackout attire guidelines are suggestions and are not mandatory.

Boys and girls are combined for pre beginner, beginner, novice, and PW. Age groups may be combined if there are less than 5 competitors.

First Feis (One step, one at a time) This category is open to girls and boys under 6 years of age and is an introduction to a Feis. Dancers will have the opportunity to perform one step in their reel and jig. All dancers will receive the same recognition at the stage immediately after the competition concludes.
