Must still enter your regular grade level dances at the feis to be eligible.

All Future Champions will compete REEL (3 steps) and JIG (3 steps)

All dancers will dance 2 at a time on a shared stage.

After the competition, dancers will be awarded in a live ceremony at the podium.

PRELIMINARY CHAMPIONSHIP

CEILI COMPETITIONS

REGISTRATION PROCESS: Only one team member needs to register and will be charged the fee for the entire team. Only the team member who registers will have their dancer number in the stage book and will be considered the "team captain" for whom scores will be given. The "team captain" MUST wear the dancer number that was used to register the team.

*It is not necessary to notify the Feis nor FEISWEB who the other team members will be.

*The team age group is determined by the OLDEST dancer on their team.

*Dancers may compete more than once in the same age group (i.e. mixed & girls team).

*All ADULT team members must be ADULT category solos.

For teams, each participating dancer should enter 15TR on FeisWeb. Alternately, dancers & groups may enter and pay side-stage that evening. TEAMS get to CHOOSE their OWN music for their team treble reel! Please remember to bring your APPROPRIATE music to plug in!

Individual dancers will have a reel played for them and do a step down the line.
