1. Entries will only be accepted from Teachers registered with An Coimisiun le Rince Gaelacha.
2. Objections must be lodged in writing by registered teachers only, within 1 hour following the announcement of a competition result be accompanied by the fee of 20 euro
3. Videoing of competitions is strictly forbidden.
4. The Feis Committee will not accept responsibility for personal injuries or articles lost at the feis.
5. Age to be taken from 1st January 2022.
6. The use of fake tan, make up, wigs, and solo costumes are strictly forbidden in Bungrad and Tusgrad competitions. This is a Connacht ruling and we would appreciate anyone travelling from other regions to abide by this rule. Also take note, Teachers/parents of new make up and costume rulings effective from March 2014, where all dancers up to and including Under 10 will not be permitted to wear make up or fake tan. Children of all ags must be able to lift both arms to shoulder level in all costumes.
7. No Block, enpointe work (stationary or moving) is allowed to be performed for all ages up to and including Under 12.
8. There will be a strict no refund policy on entries that cannot attend. However a full refund will be given if the event is cancelled.

9. Bungrad competitions are confined to competitors who have never won first place for that particular dance in any age group.

Tusgrad competitions are confined to competitors who have never won first place for that particular dance in Tus, Mean or Ard.

Meangrad competitions are confined to competitors who have never won first place for that particular dance in Mean or Ard.

Preliminary competitions - to be eligible to compete in a Preliminary Championship

- Dancers must not have placed in a top 3 in an open championship judged by 3 or more adjudicators
- Dancers must not have won a Preliminary Championship more than 2 times in the current year However, if there are 5 or less in a preliminary competition is still eligible to compete in Preliminary Championship
- Dancers must not have qualified for Oireachtas Rince na Cruinne in the current year (2022) or previous year (2021)
- Dancers must not have recalled in the actual Championship in Oireachtas Rince Na hEireann in the current year 2022 or previous year 2021
- Dancers having won 2 preliminary championship may not compete in any Mean Grad competition for the remainder of the year however, if a dancer has won only one preliminary championship they may continue to compete in Mean Grad (with the exception of the dances with which they won the Preliminary Championship)
