RULES:

- Age will be reckoned from 1st January 2023.
- Entries accepted only from schools registered with An Coimisiun le Rinci Gaelacha.
- The Adjudicator's decision is final. Adjudicators are only to be approached by Committee members.
- Any objections must be made in writing to feis organisers within one hour, signed and accompanied by a fee of
 - €20 which will be returned if objection is sustained.
- The feis committee will not be responsible for any personal injury or articles lost at the feis. The committee, as far as practical, will provide a stage surface suitable for dancing. However, the committee cannot accept any liability whatsoever for injuries sustained while on stage. The lodgement of any entry will be deemed to be acceptance of these rules by a dancer and his/her parents/guardian.
- Any form of unauthorised photography which has the ability to capture a dancer's image whilst in motion is strictly forbidden. The use of camcorders is also forbidden during dancing.
- Bungrád competitions are confined to those who have never won a first prize in that particular dance in any age group. Only basic steps may be performed.
- Túsgrád competitions are confined to dancers who have not won a first prize in that particular dance in Túsgrád, Meángrád or Árdgrád.
- Competitors in Bungrád and Túsgrád may only wear class costume, dress or skirt and top and the use of make-up, fake tan and wigs is not permissible.
- Meángrád competitions are confined to dancers who have not won a first prize in that particular dance in Meán- grád or Árdgrád. No block, en-pointe work, stationary or moving, is allowed to be performed in all ages up to and including Under 12.

- PRELIMINARY RULES (Please read carefully)

- To be eligible to compete in a Preliminary Championship:
- Dancers must not have placed in the top 3 in an Open Championship judged by 3 or more adjudicators.
- Dancers must not have won a Preliminary Championship more than 2 times in the current year,
 HOWEVER, if there are 5 are less in a Preliminary competition the dancer is still eligible to compete in Preliminary Champi- onship.
- Dancers must not have qualified for Oireachtas Rince na Cruinne in the current year (2023) or previous year (2022).
- Dancers must not have recalled in the actual Championship at Oireachtas Rince na hEireann in the current year (2023) or previous year (2022).
- Dancers having won 2 Preliminary Championships may not compete in any Mean grad competition for the remainder of the year HOWEVER, if a dancer has won only one Preliminary Championship they may continue to compete in Mean grad (with the exception of the dances that they won the Prelim Championship with).
