

Note for dancers competing at the Colorado Gold Feis on Saturday, September 16:

Any dancers who move up in level at Colorado Gold Feis on Saturday can pay a \$10 fee to change competitions for Colorado Summerset Feis on Sunday.

Feisworx can make these changes **starting Sunday morning** (not on Saturday afternoon). Please plan on arriving a little early on Sunday to give yourself time to get your competition changed. Thanks!

Requirement for Specials

Irish Ballad Singing Competition—singers will perform two traditional, unaccompanied Irish or Irish-American ballads, one slow and one faster. Songs must be memorized. Open to everyone. Adults and kids will compete separately.

Warmup Reel—each dancer will do 1 step of the soft shoe reel down the line. This special is designed to help dancers warm up at the start of their competition. Grades and Champions will have separate competitions.

Grade Treble Reel—each dancer will do 1 step of the hard shoe reel down the line. Open to Beginner 1 through Prizewinner dancers.

Prelim Non-Traditional Set—dancers will compete with a non-traditional set dance of their choice, dancing 1 at a time. Open to Preliminary Champions and Adult Champions.

Champion Traditional Set—dancers will compete with any traditional set. We will decide based on entry numbers if dancers will go 1 or 2 at a time. Open to Preliminary and Open Champions.

Tag Team Championship—have you ever wished you could just do one step of your champ dance instead of three? Now's your chance! Teams of three champs will take turns doing 1 step at a time of either reel or slip jig, then 1 step at a time of either hornpipe or double jig; team members will finish by performing the same traditional set all together. Open to Preliminary, Open, and Adult Champions of any age (teams can be made up of a mix of ages and champ levels. The whole team must do the same soft shoe, hard shoe, and trad set dances).

Solo Competitions: grade dancers will go two at a time and perform 32 bars of each dance, except for the traditional set competitions, where dancers will go three at a time and perform the entire dance.

Requirements: Preliminary Champions will compete with 2 rounds—reel or slip jig and double jig or hornpipe. Open Champions will compete with 3 rounds—reel or slip jig, double jig or hornpipe, and set dance. All U9 Opens must compete with a traditional set dance. Championship competitions will start with the soft shoe round, and dancers will go two at a time.
