CEILI COMPETITIONS

REGISTRATION PROCESS: Only one team member needs to register and will be charged the fee for the entire team. Only the team member who registers will have their dancer number in the stage book and will be considered the “team captain” for whom scores will be given. The “team captain” MUST wear the dancer number that was used to register the team.

*It is not necessary to notify the Feis nor FEISWEB who the other team members will be.

*The team age group is determined by the OLDEST dancer on their team.

*Dancers may compete more than once in the same age group (i.e. mixed & girls team).

*All ADULT team members must be ADULT category solos.
