FEIS RULES

- 1. Competitors must be pupils of teachers registered with An Coimisiun le Rinci Gaelacha, Dublin and be registered to compete with an appropriate regional authority for 2023.
- 2. Entries must be submitted on the official form and accompanied by the correct fee and signed by the registered teacher. No refunds will be given.
- 3. The organizer reserves the right to cancel, modify or combine age groups for any sections should the need arise.
- 4. Competitors may dance in ONE PREMIERSHIP and up to 2 SOLO DANCES or up to 5 SOLO DANCES. The warmup dance and stepabouts are NOT included in your dances.
- 5. All dancers must report to the marshalling area when called or risk disqualification.
- 6. Please be ready to dance at least 30 minutes before the scheduled time.
- 7. Music will be provided by the organizer at AIDA speeds.
- 8. A dancer may be permitted to re-dance if: there is a problem with the music, loss of a heel or complete shoe PROVIDED that the dancer stands back and allows the other dancer(s) to continue dancing OR at the adjudicator's discretion.
- 9. The adjudicator's decision is final.
- 10. Competitors enter at their own risk regarding injury.
- 11. Dances MUST be in FULL costume (including shoes) to receive prizes.
- 12. Any form of photography (mobile phone, camera, video etc) is STRICTLY FORBIDDEN with the exception of NOVICE and BEGINNER sections. NON-FLASH photography is allowed from a specific area in the hall authorized by the organizer. Anyone not complying may be asked to leave the venue.
- 13. Costumes MUST comply with the current guidelines adopted by AIDA Inc. Appropriate underwear covering the midriff must be worn. Tights MUST be not less than 70 denier. Rule: 5.1.6 Beginner (Bun) and Primary (Tus) up to and including Under 12 may ONLY wear traditional class costumes or short/long sleeved blouses/shirts and skirts/trousers; body suits and skirts regular length. Low cut tops and short tight skirts/skorts ARE NOT PERMITTED.
- 14. Makeup is NOT permitted for any dancer in Beginner or Primary up to and including the Under 12 age group or any intermediate, reserve or open dancer in the Under 10 age group.
- 15. NO block, en point, stationary or moving will be allowed for all ages up to and including 11 years and under.
- 16. In Hard shoe jig and Hornpipe the lead must be dance on both right and left foot.
- 17. No artificial arm aids permitted.
- 18. Lodgement of an entry form shall be taken to signify that the teacher, dancer and parent/guardian accept and agree to strictly adhere to all of the above rules.

Premiership: Reel, Single Jig, Hard shoe Jig (Under 10 2 steps; 11 & Over 3)

RESERVE: Solos: Reel, Slip Jig, Hard Shoe Jig, Hornpipe, Own Choice Set Dance

Premiership: Reel or Slip Jig, Jig or Hornpipe, Traditional Set Dance

OPEN: Solos: Reel, Slip Jig, Own Choice Set Dance, Jig, Hornpipe

Premiership: Reel or Slip Jig, Jig or Hornpipe, Traditional Set Dance

ADULT 1 Solos: Beginner or Primary Reel, Light Jig, Slip Jig, Hard shoe Jig, Traditional Set Dance

Premiership: Reel, Light Jig, Single Jig

ADULT 2 Solos: Open reel, Light Jig, Slip Jig, Hard shoe Jig, Hornpipe

Premiership: Reel, Single Jig, Traditional Set Dance

Warm Up Dance – ALL levels REEL

Stepabout Light Any level REEL step(s) for 16 bars at speed 113 SOFT SHOE

Stepabout Treble Reel Any level for 16 bars at reel speed 113 HARD SHOE
