Dear friends,

It is with great pleasure that we invite you to the third edition of the Mountain Rose feis this year. It is organised by the Rose Irish Dance School, and it will be held in one of the oldest cities in the Netherlands: Bergen op Zoom. Antwerp (40 km), Breda (40 km) and Rotterdam (70 km) are not far away. The nearest airports are: Rotterdam - The Hague Airport (78 km), Brussels Airport (83 km), Eindhoven Airport (91 km) and Schiphol (Amsterdam - 131 km).

The story behind the name of Mountain Rose Feis, is that the literal translation of Bergen (op Zoom) means mountains. And of course the Rose couldn't be forgotten in this name, so that is why we chose for the Mountain Rose.

The venue of the feis will be RSG 't Rijks, a high school located not far from the city centre in Bergen op Zoom. The school itself is on the edge of a paid parking zone, to see where you need to pay, and where it's free to park your car, take a look at this map with all the paid parking zones in Bergen op Zoom: https://goo.gl/maps/NdnBnxHPe4Xh6uNr8

The school itself offers a large feis hall with a 8 x 5m floor and a big changing room. The feis will be run on one floor.

There will be trophies for all first places and medals for runners up. In traditional set dances, trophy dances and the treble reel the first places will receive a trophy. In premier championships the first three places will receive a trophy. Please note that this year for the first time, the treble reel is a themed competition, and we hope you will enjoy the idea that it is a Barbie-themed competition!

We are looking forward to see you all in Bergen op Zoom at the end of September and good luck to everybody preparing to dance at our feis!

FEIS RULES

The Feis will run in accordance with the Rules of An Coimisiún Le Rincí Gaelacha. Entries will only be accepted from persons currently registered with An Coimisiún.

GRADE COMPETITION RULES

- 1. **Beginners Grade** competitions are confined to dancers who have never won 1st, 2nd or 3rd prize (please refer to the grid) in any competition for that particular dance.
- 2. In **Beginners Grade** competitions only basic steps may be performed.
- 3. **Primary Grade** competitions are confined to dancers who have never won 1st, 2nd or 3rd prize prize (please refer to the grid) for that particular dance other than in Beginners Grade.
- 4. Intermediate Grade competitions are open to all dancers who have not previously won 1st or 2nd prize (please refer to the grid) for that particular dance in Intermediate under the same or higher age limits.
 If a dancer in Continental Europe and Asia wins in Intermediate, they advance to the next level for the rest of the calendar year. Teachers can move dancers back at their own discretion at the start of the next calendar year.

For all Beginner, Primary and Intermediate competitions (excluding trophy competitions) the 32 bar method will be applied.

Two and three hands are danced to 40 bars of music. Ceíli and figure dances are subject to the rules applied at Oireachtasi. All **Open Championship** dancers will be required to dance to 48 bars of music in the reel and jig and 40 bars in the slip-jig and hornpipe.

TROPHY & CHAMPIONSHIP RULES

- 6. **Traditional Set Dance** competitions, dancers will have a choice out of 7 traditional dance: St. Patrick's Day, Blackbird, Job of Journeywork, Garden of Daisies, King of Fairies, Jockey to the Fair & Three sea Captains. If a dancer win a first place in any traditional set dance competition, that dancer move on the next level in all 7 traditional set dances.
- 7. **Traditional Set Dances** may only be performed in the following competitions: Traditional Set dance Competitions and Adult Championships and in the Under 11 Open Championships.
- 8. **Beginner**, **Primary** and **Intermediate Trophy** competitions, will be a choice of light and heavy dance. Dancers will dance 16 bars down the line in their chosen dance(s).
- 9. **Premier Championships** will be judged by one adjudicator, as two solos and then an Overall result. The Competition is for Intermediate/ Open dancers, they will be required to dance 48 bars of music for the Reel or Heavy Jig, 40 bars of music for the Slip Jig or Hornpipe, and a MODERN SET.
- 10. **Adult Championships** are open to dancers of Intermediate and above level who have never won a 1st, 2nd or 3rd place in an Open Championship and are not participating in a full Open Championship at the same feis. Dancers are required to dance to 32 bars of music and will dance a choice of soft shoe (Reel or Slip Jig for ladies and Reel for gentlemen), heavy shoe (Heavy Jig or Hornpipe) and a Traditional Set. *Please note these Championships have been created for dancers who started Irish Dancing as ADULTS*.
- 11. Where there are 5 or less dancers in any Championship placement will not affect grading.

OFFICIAL CLRG RULES

- 12. The lodgement of an entry will be taken to mean that teachers and pupils understand these rules and undertake to abide by them.
- 13. **Objections** must be lodged in writing within one hour of the announcement of the result of a competition accompanied by a fee of 40 Euro, which will be refunded if the objection is upheld.
- 14. The Adjudicators' decisions are final.
- 15. Only Feis officials may approach the adjudicators during competition sessions.
- 16. **Age** will be taken as on 1st January 2023 (whatever age you turn this year, in 2023, you dance under that age all year long, e.g. if a dancer's date of birth is 29 May 2002, he/she dances under 10 in the year 2012). Evidence of age may be requested, therefore dancers should have a valid ID with them in the event of a query as to their age.
- 17. Competitors must be in costume and ready to dance 30 minutes before their competitions are scheduled.
- 18. The **dress code** in accordance with An Coimisiún rules will be strictly observed. For the sake of modesty and in the interest of safety to young people, dancers will not be permitted to walk around the Feis scantily dressed.
- 19. All **Beginners** and **Primary** dancers of all age groups may only wear a class costume, simple dancewear or appropriate attire (skirt and top/blouse, simple dress for girls and ladies, trousers and t-shirt/shirt for boys and gents. Make-up is not permitted for any dancer in the first two grades up to and including the Under 12 age group worldwide.
- 20. The **Costume Rules** of An Coimisiún, as amended, also apply in Continental Europe and Asia; it can be found in the "Rules" section on www.clrg.ie for reference. Female adult dancers participating in competitions entitled 'adult competition' and/or 'adult grade competition' (both solo and team) are required to wear tights of a denier not less than 70.
- 21. Team dances (four hands and upward) must be performed as per the Coimisiún handbook "Ar Rinci Ceili"
- 22. By entering in competitions, dancers (or their legal representatives, in case of minors) consent to their names being stated in the feis results and in the public Internet archives or any other feis entry/results system as may replace it.
- 23. Provided that dancers are not disturbed by flashlights or the like, photography and video recording by persons other than official feis photographers is allowed during **Beginners** and **Primary** competitions and during **ALL** award ceremonies. During **Intermediate** and **Open** competitions, ONLY the official feis photographer is permitted to take photos. Those who do not wish to be photographed should make themselves known to the Feis Organisers.
- 24. An Coimisiun has ruled that from 1st January each year, no block, en pointe, stationary or moving, be allowed to be performed for all ages up to and including the under 12 age group worldwide. The Under 12 Age Group will be allowed to toe walk from September 1st.
- 25. Within the limits specified in the Rules of An Coimisiún, the Organisers may at their discretion cancel or combine competitions with insufficient entries.
- 26. Order and quiet must be kept in the hall, particularly while competitors are dancing.
- 27. The Feis organisers cannot accept any liability for injury or loss or damage to property while on the premises.
- 28. No **refunds** will be made.

EXTRA MOUNTAIN ROSE FEIS RULES

31. Dancers competing in the **Treble Reel** Competitions will dance 16 bars down the line Creative Freestyle. Therefore use of hands, improvised steps and non-traditional dance wear in accordance with the feis theme are permitted.
