<b>Specials - Future Champs</b>	<p>Future champs competition is designed for U10 and younger dancer who are currently in the grade levels and preparing to move up or compete at a major championship. <b>Open to dancers NOT currently competing in Preliminary or Open Championship.</b> This event provides a practice opportunity with awards and placements, though results will not count for a level change. <b>Competition Requirements:</b></p> <p><b>Soft Shoe:</b> Reel (3 steps/48 bars)</p> <p><b>Hard Shoe:</b> Treble Jig (3 steps/48 bars OR Hornpipe (2 1/2 steps/40 bars)</p> <p>This is a great change for young dancers to gain experience and confidence on stage!</p>

<b>Special First Feis</b>	Competition open to all dancers who are stepping onto the competition stage for the first time. Minimum of one step, but may compete up to two. These dancers may also enter the beginner competition.
<b>Reel, Light Jig, or Single Jig</b>	002FF

<b>Adult Competitions</b>	A dancer over the age of 18 who has not danced in the above described competitions for a period of five years. Dancers in the Adult categories cannot enter any competition other than Adult competitions. A dancer who wishes to return to any category other than Adult must remain out of Adult competitions until retired from dancing for five consecutive years.
